Find out about the proposed improvements for the Route 17/50/522 (Millwood Pike) Bridge over Interstate 81 that extends from 0.13-mile east of the intersection with Apple Blossom Drive to 0.05-mile west of the intersection with Tulane Drive in Frederick County.

The hearing will be held as a virtual/online event. VDOT representatives will make a presentation beginning at 4 p.m. and be present to answer questions after the presentation is completed. The presentation will be available for review throughout the comment period.
