



Route 811 (Thomas Jefferson Road) Intersection Improvement Bedford County

Find out about a project to add a right turn lane from northbound Route 811 onto Route 622 (Waterlick Road). The new turn lane will enhance traffic flow, reduce traffic queues and improve safety by allowing turning vehicles to separate from through traffic. Currently, vehicles turning right and traveling through the intersection share a lane.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
