Find out about a project to install approximately 12,000 linear feet of sidewalk along two miles of Route 11/460 (West Main Street) in Roanoke County between Salem and Route 830 (Technology Drive). The project also involves installing crosswalks and providing pedestrian signals at West Main Street's signalized intersections with Route 643 (Daugherty Road) and Route 642/Route 929 (Alleghany Drive/Garman Road). The hearing will be held in an "open-house" format and VDOT representatives will be present to answer questions.
