



Route 715 (Lowry Road) Bridge Replacement Bedford County

Find out about plans to replace the Route 715 bridge over the railroad tracks in the Lowry community in Bedford County. The bridge is located about a mile north of Route 671 (Timber Ridge Road) and 0.6 mile south of Route 786 (Founding Way Road). The project entails replacing the existing one-lane bridge with a two-lane structure that meets current standards.

Review the project information and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation in the form of a Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Salem District Office located at 731 Harrison Ave. in Salem, 540-387-5353, 800-FOR-ROAD (367-7623), TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Steve Mullins, Virginia Department of Transportation, 731 Harrison Avenue, Salem, VA 24153 on or prior to **September 20, 2018**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
