

**Brandy Station Park and Ride
Culpeper County
Expansion of existing
Park and Ride lot**

Find out about the proposed plans to increase the capacity of the existing Park and Ride lot at Route 15/29 (James Madison Highway), Route 663 (Alanthus Road) and Route 685 (Fleetwood Heights Road) in Culpeper County. The project will expand the lot from 45 spaces to 95 spaces with improved access and lighting.

Review the project information and the National Environmental Policy Act documentation in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Culpeper District Office located at 1601 Orange Road in Culpeper, VA, 540-829-7500 or at VDOT's Warrenton Residency, located at 457 E. Shirley Avenue, Warrenton, VA 20186, 540-347-6441, or 1-800-367-7623, TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is provided in the environmental documentation.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. David Cabbage, Project Manager, Virginia Department of Transportation, 1601 Orange Road, Culpeper, VA 22701 on or prior to **November 22, 2017**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
