

## **Route 690 (Ennis Mill Road) over Ennis Pond Bridge Isle of Wight County**

### **Willingness to Hold Public Hearing**

Find out about the proposed bridge replacement over Ennis Pond. The limits of the project are 0.90 miles North of Windsor Blvd. to 0.97 miles North of Windsor Blvd. for a total project length of approximately 0.07 miles, including the bridge.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a combined location and design public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Mr. Chris Eggleston, P.E., District Project Development Engineer, Virginia Department of Transportation, 7511 Burbage Drive, Suffolk, VA. 23435 on or prior to **December 20th, 2018**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
