VDOT in conjunction with Faulconer Construction will hold two "Pardon Our Dust" public information meetings to discuss construction impacts and traffic management for the upcoming project to improve safety on 9.65 miles of Route 220 between Iron Gate and the James River Bridge near Eagle Rock. The same information will be presented at each meeting. The project to reconstruct Route 220 as improved two-lane road will incorporate various safety measures such as improved alignment, widen shoulders, edge-line rumble strips, additional turn lanes and more passing zones.

There will be a brief presentation given at 5:15 p.m. and 6:15 p.m. In an open house format, representatives will answer questions and provide information about construction phasing, traffic impacts and property accessibility during the four-year project that will begin this spring.
