Find out about a proposed project to replace the 48-year-old Route 629 (Deep Creek Road) bridge over Middle Fork Kent Branch in Fluvanna County. The bridge, which was built in 1969 and is located 0.2 mile east of Route 631 (Dogwood Drive), is considered structurally deficient.

Review the proposed project plans and the National Environmental Policy Act documentation in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or at VDOT's Culpeper District Office located at 1601 Orange Road in Culpeper, VA, 540-829-7500 and VDOT's Louisa Residency, located at 3709 Davis Highway, Louisa, VA 23093, 540-967-3710, or 1-800-367-7623, TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is provided in the environmental documentation.

Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above addresses and will be available at the public hearing.
