



Route 115 (Plantation Road) and Lila Drive Intersection Improvement Project Roanoke County

Find out about a road project to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Plantation Road and Lila Drive in Roanoke County. The project also includes installing crosswalks with pedestrian signals and constructing approximately 600 feet of new sidewalk. Commercial entrances near the intersection also will be realigned or consolidated.

Review the project information and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Salem District Office located at 731 Harrison Ave. in Salem, 540-387-5353, 800-FOR-ROAD (367-7623), TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Ashley Smith, Virginia Department of Transportation, 731 Harrison Avenue, Salem, VA 24153 on or prior to **January 18, 2018**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
