Find out about a proposed project to replace the substandard Route 635 (Greenwood Road) bridge over the Norfolk Southern Railway in Orange County. The bridge was built in 1942 and is currently posted with an 11-ton weight restriction. About 290 vehicles use the bridge daily, according to a 2016 traffic count.
