Find out about the proposed construction of Route 744 (Southern Gap Road) in Buchanan County, which will connect to the future Route 121 (Coalfields Expressway) Hawk Nest section. The project will construct two 12-foot-wide travel lanes with 4-foot paved and 4-foot graded shoulders on the 1.4 mile graded road bed already in place.

Review the proposed project plans and environmental document in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at the VDOT Bristol District Office located at 870 Bonham Road in Bristol, VA, 276-669-6151, 800-367-7623, TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to **Mr. Robert Leonard, P.E., VDOT Project Manager**, 870 Bonham Road, Bristol, Virginia, 24201, prior to **October 25, 2017**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
