

Route 601 Bridge Replacement over Diascund Creek James City County

Willingness to Hold a Public Hearing

Find out about the proposed bridge replacement on Route 601 (Hicks Island Road) over Diascund Creek in James City County.

Come and see the proposed project plans to replace the one-lane steel girder and timber deck bridge with a new, wider one-lane bridge.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Nancy Marshall, Virginia Department of Transportation, 1700 N Main St, Suffolk, VA 23434 on or prior to **September 28, 2017**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
