## **HAMPTON ROADS WEEKLY LANE-CLOSURES REPORT** *For the week of December 3-9*

### **I-64 Widening Project, Newport News/York County:**

#### **Segment II**

- Alternating single-lane closures on I-64 east and west from Colonial Parkway to Lee Hall (Exit 247) December 3-7, starting as early as 7 p.m. until 5 a.m.
- Full ramp closures on I-64 with signed detours in place, on December 3-7, starting as early as 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. as follows:
  - I-64 west off-ramp to Route 143 (exit 243B)
  - I-64 east on- and off-ramps at Route 199 west (exit 242A)
  - I-64 west on-ramp from Route 199 east
- Lane closures under flagger control on Penniman Road at the I-64 overpasses on December 3-7, from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. the following morning.

#### **I-64, Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel:**

- Single-lane closures as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:
  - I-64 east from the HRBT to the Hampton River Bridge December 3-7 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
  - I-64 east from the Willoughby Bridge to I-564 December 3-6 from 8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.

#### **I-664, Monitor-Merrimac Memorial Bridge-Tunnel, Newport News:** Single-lane closures as follows. One lane will remain open at all times.

- Alternating lane closures I-664 north between MMMBT and 25<sup>th</sup> Street (Exit 6). One lane will remain open at all times.
  - December 2 from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m.
  - December 3 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
  - December 4-7 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
  - December 8 from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.

- December 9 from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m.

**I-64, High Rise Bridge:**

- I-64 east single-lane closure December 3 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. with stoppages between 11 p.m. and 4 a.m.
- I-64 west single-lane closure December 4-7 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. with stoppages between midnight and 5 a.m.
- I-64 west single-lane closure. One lane will remain open at all times.
  - December 8 from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m.
  - December 9 from 8 p.m. to 10 a.m.
  - December 10 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

**I-64, Peninsula:**

- I-64 east off-ramp (exit 243A) to Busch Gardens slow rolling work December 3-7 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- I-64 west at Camp Peary single-lane closure December 3-5 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

**I-64, Southside:**

- I-64 east off-ramp to Indian River Road in both directions slow rolling work December 3-7 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- I-64 east off-ramp to Northampton Boulevard east will be closed December 6 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

**I-64 Reversible Roadway:** The Reversible Roadway will be closed December 3-9 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

**Route 17, James River Bridge:**

- Route 17 south single-lane closure December 4-8 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**I-564, Norfolk:**

- I-564 west single-lane closure at the Runway Tunnel
  - December 4-6 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
  - December 5 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
  - December 6 from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

**Military Highway Continuous Flow Intersection, Norfolk:**

- I-64 east off-ramp to Military Highway (Exit 281B) will be closed December 3-5 and December 7 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Detour signs will direct motorists to Exit 281A/Robin Hood Road.
- Alternating single-lane closures will be from December 3 – December 9 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- One lane will remain open at all times on:
  - Military Highway between Valley Drive and Lynn Street.

- Princess Anne Road between Sigmon Street and Military Highway.
- Northampton Boulevard between Military Highway and past USAA Drive.
- Robin Hood Road between Military Highway and Miller Store Road.

**Turnpike Road Reconstruction Project, Portsmouth:**

- One northbound lane of Frederick Boulevard is open at the Turnpike Road intersection. Southbound Frederick Boulevard is closed. Signed detour in place.

**Smithfield:** Alternating lane closures in both directions. One lane will remain open at all times:

- U.S. 258 over Cypress Creek single-lane closure December 6 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- VA-10 over Pagan River single-lane closure December 7 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

**Isle of Wight:** Alternating lane closures. One lane will remain open at all times:

- VA-10 at Benns Church single-lane closures in both directions December 4-7 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- U.S. 258 at Joyners Bridge Rd. flagger controlled stoppages in both directions December 4-7 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**Route 60 (Pocahontas Trail), James City County:**

- Full closure in both directions, stoppages managed by flaggers at Skiffes Boulevard. December 4-8 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**Courtland Interchange Project: US-58, Southampton County:** Alternating lane closures in both directions on U.S. 58 as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:

- Starting at 6 a.m. December 4 and ending no later than noon December 8 between Old Bridge Road (Route 742) and Shady Brook Trail (Route 650).

**I-95 North, Greensville County:** Single-lane closures at the ramp at mile marker 16 December 6 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. One lane will remain open at all times.

**Elizabeth River Tunnels/Martin Luther King Expressway:** Go to [Elizabeth River Tunnels](#) for the latest project and traffic updates regarding the Downtown Tunnel (I-264), Midtown Tunnel (U.S. 58) and Route 164 MLK Expressway.
