PAVING WORK TO IMPACT NEIGHBORHOOD ENTRANCES ON HOLLAND ROAD CONNECTION PROJECT

Only one neighborhood entrance will be affected at a time

VIRGINIA BEACH— Paving work on the Holland Road Connection Project will result in impacts to some neighborhood entrances on Holland Road beginning Monday, March 20. The work will take place under flagging operations at each entrance and no detours will be used. Only one neighborhood entrance will be affected at a time. This work will last for three weeks as crews begin paving permanent roadway on the northbound lane of Holland Road from Dam Neck Road to Nimmo Parkway. The following neighborhood entrances will be impacted by flagging operations at separate times:

- Parkside Green neighborhood on Saville Garden Way
- Greenwood neighborhood on Chestnut Oak Way
- Holland Oaks neighborhood on Sugar Maple Drive
- Holland Pines neighborhood on Chestwood Drive

Motorists must follow the detour signs. Also, drivers are advised that the reduced 35 mph speed limit remains in effect throughout the work zone.
