REMINDER: I-264 EAST DOWNTOWN TUNNEL OPEN THIS WEEKEND

PORTSMOUTH – The Interstate 264 (I-264) East Downtown Tunnel will remain open this weekend. [The Elizabeth River Tunnels](#) (ERT) Project team, in partnership with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), will resume full eastbound Downtown Tunnel weekend closures Friday, April 17.

The Downtown Tunnel **eastbound** to Norfolk closure schedule is as follows:

- **Full direction weekend closures:**
 - April 10-13: No scheduled closures.
 - April 17-20: Closed Friday at 8 p.m. until Monday at 5 a.m.
- **Single lane closures:** Sunday through Wednesday, April 12-15 from 8 p.m. each night until 5 a.m. the following morning.

The Elizabeth River Tunnels Project in Norfolk and Portsmouth, Virginia, provides critical transportation infrastructure to the Hampton Roads region. It involves design, construction, finance, operations and maintenance responsibilities for a new Midtown Tunnel and MLK Freeway Extension; existing tunnel rehabilitation; interchange modifications; and incident response, snow removal and roadway repairs for more than 50 lane miles within the project area. Headquartered in Portsmouth, Virginia, this public-private partnership is comprised of Elizabeth River Crossings OpCo, LLC and the Virginia Department of Transportation.
