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HAMPTON ROADS AREA LANE CLOSURE FORECAST

For the week of November 8 through November 14

Hampton Roads, Va. - In an effort to keep you informed, VDOT publishes the following scheduled highway lane closures that may affect traffic in Hampton Roads. These closures are subject to change due to weather conditions and other unforeseen events. Other closures may occur which do not appear on this report.

YORK COUNTY

Route 17 North /South – Motorists should expect traffic shifts at the Amoco Industrial Track for CSX highway asphalt operations, Friday, November 13 at 11 p.m. through Monday, November 16, at 11 p.m. In this area of Route 17, paralleling Route 634, motorists should expect a single lane closure and two-way traffic heading north and south bound. Delays are expected and motorists should be alert to the traffic shifts.

I-64 East/West – Motorists should expect mobile lane closures from the Croaker Interchange (Exit 231) to the New Kent County line (Exit 220) for pavement marking operations, Thursday, November 12, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

JAMES CITY COUNTY

Route 60 East/West – Motorists should expect alternating lane closures from the Route 60/Route 30/Route 143 Intersection (Anderson's Corner) to Route 620 west bound, and from the New Kent County line to Route 657 (Ivy Hill Road) east bound for concrete pavement repair, Monday, November 9, through Friday, November 13, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. The project is expected to last through November 2009.

HAMPTON/NEWPORT NEWS

I-664 North/South – Motorists should expect mobile lane closures from the I-64 Interchange (Exit 1) to Terminal Avenue (Exit 7) for drain cleaning operations, Sunday, November 8, through Saturday, November 14, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

HAMPTON/NORFOLK/VIRGINIA BEACH/CHESAPEAKE

I-64 East/West – Motorists should expect mobile, alternating lane closures from Mallory Street (Exit 268) to the Bowers Hill Interchange (Exit 299) for pothole repair, Sunday, November 8, through Friday, November 13, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

NEWPORT NEWS

I-64 West – Motorists should expect Mobile lane closures at Jefferson Avenue (Exit 255) for pavement marking operations, Thursday, November 12, from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m.

I-664 North – Motorists should expect multiple lane closures from Chestnut Avenue (Exit 4) to Powhatan Parkway (Exit 2) for pavement repair, Sunday, November 8, through Friday, November 13, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Jefferson Avenue Widening Project

Route 143 North/South – Through March 2010, motorists should expect alternating lane closures and traffic shifts on Jefferson Avenue from Buchanan Drive to King's Ridge for construction activity, Monday through Friday, from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Motorists should expect a new traffic pattern for the duration of the project. The work zone is now between both directions of travel lanes, eliminating left turn lanes, except those allowable at intersections.

Warwick Boulevard East/West Route 60 – Motorists should expect multiple alternating lane closures for construction activities on Warwick Boulevard from Nettles Drive to J. Clyde Morris Boulevard, Monday through Friday. Anticipate overnight lane closures from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. on both east and west bound lanes. Daytime lane closures should be expected daily from 7 a.m. to 2 p.m. on west bound lanes only. These lane closures will be in affect through project completion in December 2009.

- Motorists should expect *daytime* lane closures on Warwick Boulevard, both east and west bound, from 7 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. for the duration of the paving project. Business entrances could be impacted for short periods east bound from Middlesex Road/Hidenwood Drive to Hiden Boulevard and west bound from Nutmeg Quarter to Hiden Boulevard while paving machines move past the entrances.
- Motorists should expect alternating lane closures northbound between Sweetbriar Drive and Hiden Boulevard for paving operations, Monday, November 9, through Friday, November 13, from 7 a.m. to noon.

JAMES RIVER BRIDGE

Route 17 South – Motorists should expect a single lane closure on the James River Bridge for bridge deck repairs, Sunday, November 8, through Friday, November 13, from 6 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Route 17 North/South – Motorists should expect a single lane closure for gate, signal and roadway maintenance from River Road to Kings Cove Way, Tuesday, November 10, through Friday, November 13, from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

HAMPTON ROADS BRIDGE-TUNNEL

I-64 East – Motorist should expect overnight single lane closures Sunday through Thursday, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for the roadway lighting upgrade to the I-64 East Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel. Westbound traffic will not be affected and no weekend closures are planned. The project is scheduled for completion in spring 2011.

Motorists are encouraged to use I-664 Monitor Merrimac Memorial Bridge Tunnel to avoid delays. Take Exit 264 to access I-664. Use exit 15A for Norfolk and Virginia Beach destinations. Use exit 15B for Chesapeake and Outer Banks destinations.

DOWNTOWN TUNNEL

I-264 East/West – Motorists should expect mobile lane closures through the Downtown Tunnel, over the Berkley Bridge and at I-464 on and off ramps, for sweeping operations Tuesday, November 10, and Friday, November 13, from midnight to 5 a.m.

I-264 East – Motorists should expect a single left lane closure through the Downtown Tunnel and across the Berkley Bridge for bridge house roof and electrical repairs, Saturday, November 7, and Sunday, November 8, from 5 a.m. to 9 p.m.

NORFOLK

Princess Anne Road Widening Project

Motorists should expect multiple lane closures and traffic shifts for paving operations between Coward Street and Sigmon Street, Monday, November 9, through Friday, November 13, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Motorists will be directed and should be alert for flagging operations.

Virginia Beach Boulevard Widening Project

Route 58 East/West – Motorists should expect alternating lane closures between Military Highway and Jett Street for storm water and sewer pipe installation, Monday, November 9, through Friday, November 13, from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Hampton Boulevard Grading Project

Motorists should expect multiple alternating lane closures, both north and south bound on Hampton Boulevard between “B” Avenue and Greenbrier Avenue for utility operations, Monday, November 9, through Thursday, November 12, from 5 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Motorists should expect multiple lane closures on Hampton Boulevard, between B Avenue and Fleet Access Road, alternating north and south bound, Monday, November 9, through Friday, November 13, from 5 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Greenbrier Avenue *will be closed* from Hampton Boulevard to Laurel Avenue for utility installation, Monday, November 9, through Saturday, November 14, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Hampton Boulevard will be closed north bound between Rogers and Mapleshade Avenue for utility installation, Monday, November 9, through Friday, November 13, from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

NORFOLK/VIRGINIA BEACH

I-264 East/West – Motorists should expect single lane closures from Waterside (Exit 9) to Lynnhaven Parkway (Exit 19) for sweeping and drain cleaning operations from Sunday, November 8, through Saturday, November 14, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

I-64 East/West – Motorists should expect mobile lane closures from the High Rise Bridge to the I-264 Interchange (Exit 284) for sweeping and drain cleaning operations, Monday, November 9, through Friday, November 13, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

PORTSMOUTH

Route 164 Western Freeway – Motorists should expect mobile lane closures on the Western Freeway for drain cleaning operations, Sunday, November 8, through Saturday, November 14, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

I-264 East/West – Motorists should expect mobile alternating lane closures from Greenwood Drive (Exit 2) through the I-464 Interchange (Exit 8) for drain cleaning, Sunday, November 8, through Saturday, November 14, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

I-264 East – Motorists should expect multiple lane closures from Bowers Hill Interchange (Exit 1) to the Downtown Tunnel for paving operations and guardrail repair. This long term paving project will continue through November 2009. Crews will set up a single lane closure, Monday through Friday, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. throughout the term of the project.

CHESAPEAKE/NORFOLK

I-464 North – Motorists should expect alternating mobile lane closures between Military Highway (Exit 2) and the Poindexter Street Interchange (Exit 4) for pavement marking operations, Monday, November 9, through Friday, November 13, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Motorists should be alert for shoulder closures in the area.

CHESAPEAKE

I-64 East/West Restorative Pavement Project – Motorists should expect alternating lane closures from the Bowers Hill Interchange to the I-464 Interchange, Monday through Thursday, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., for restorative pavement maintenance work. Work will include patching isolated concrete pavement, increasing the width of the inside shoulder and replacing two lifts of asphalt. These paving operations will continue through August 2011.

Jollif Road/Airline Boulevard East/West – Motorists should expect single, alternating lane closures from the Jollif Road/Airline Boulevard Intersection to Flintfield Crescent for trenching operations, Tuesday, November 10, through Friday, November 13, from 8 a.m. to noon. Motorists should also be alert to shoulder closures in the area.

VIRGINIA BEACH

Lynnhaven Parkway North/South – Motorists should expect alternating lane closures on Lynnhaven Parkway between Holland Road and Lishelle Place for curb installations, Monday, November 9, through Friday, November 13, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

SUFFOLK

I-664 South – Motorists should expect an off-ramp closure at Route 17 North/Bridge Road (Exit 9) for roadway construction through November 25, 2009, from 9 a.m. to noon. Motorists will be diverted to College Drive (Exit 8).

Route 17 North/South – Motorists should expect a traffic shift between I-664 and College Drive for roadway construction. Motorists will be diverted onto the new bridge while the southbound lanes and I-664 ramps are constructed. Motorists should expect two-way traffic on the bridge through the duration of the project, which is expected to be complete in November 2009.

ISLE OF WIGHT

Route 258 East/West – Motorists should expect multiple lane closures from Route 17 to Route 10 for paving operations, Tuesday, November 10, through Saturday, November 14, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

SUSSEX

Route 35 North/South – Motorists should expect alternating lane closures from Route 622 to Route 626 for pavement repair Monday, November 9, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

CHINCOTEAGUE ISLAND/ACCOMAC

Route 175 East/West – Motorists should expect the causeway at the West end of the Black Narrows Bridge to be open to alternating one-way traffic controlled by a traffic light starting Sept. 14 and continuing until the end of the year. Motorists should also expect periodic lane closures throughout the duration of the project, Monday through Saturday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

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
