LASALLE AVENUE ON-RAMP AND I-64 EAST AUXILIARY LANE REOPEN AS COMPLETION NEARS ON BRIDGE REPAIR PROJECT

Long-term closures for repair project on I-64 bridge over Armistead Avenue reopen to traffic

HAMPTON – Emergency repair work is nearly complete beneath the I-64 east bridge over Armistead Avenue in Hampton. Over the last five months, long-term on-ramp and lane closures were in place as crews removed and replaced two box beams within the outside auxiliary ramp lane of the eastbound I-64 bridge. As of Friday, July 19, the LaSalle Avenue on-ramp and I-64 east auxiliary lane have reopened to traffic.

Motorists can expect intermittent lane closures overnight on Armistead Avenue over the next several weeks to complete the remaining work under the bridge.
