INTERMITTENT STOPPAGES UNDERWAY ON ROUTE 17 AT JAMES RIVER BRIDGE FOR MAINTENANCE REPAIRS

Motorists should expect delays Wednesday, August 8

NEWPORT NEWS/ISLE OF WIGHT—Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) bridge maintenance crews are performing tests lifts for mechanical repairs on the James River Bridge (Route 17) that require multiple intermittent traffic stops in each direction. The traffic stops are scheduled to occur today, August 8, between 10 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., and again from 7 p.m. until midnight.

Motorists may use the I-664 Monitor-Merrimac Bridge-Tunnel as an alternate route.
