HAMPTON ROADS WEEKLY LANE-CLOSURES REPORT

For the week of November 19-25

VDOT will suspend most lane closures on interstates and other major roads for Thanksgiving travel from noon Wednesday, Nov. 22, until noon Monday, Nov. 27.

I-64 Widening Project, Newport News/York County:

Segment I

- Alternating single-lane closures on I-64 east and west from Lee Hall (Exit 247) and ending near Jefferson Avenue (Exit 255) on November 18-21, starting as early as 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. Sunday night east closures will not begin before 10 p.m.
- Alternating single-lane closures on Fort Eustis Boulevard in both directions at the I-64 overpass on November 20-21, starting 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Full ramp closures on November 18, from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m.:
 - I-64 west Exit 250B to Jefferson Avenue
 - I-64 west Exit 250A to Fort Eustis Boulevard (VA-105 west)

Segment II

- Alternating single-lane closures on I-64 east and west from Colonial Parkway to Lee Hall (Exit 247) November 19-21, starting as early as 7 p.m. until 5 a.m.
- Lane closures under flagger control on Jefferson Avenue at the I-64 overpasses on November 19-21, from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m.
- Lane closures under flagger control on Penniman Road at the I-64 overpasses on November 19-21, from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m.
- Full ramp closures on I-64 with signed detours in place, starting as early as 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. as follows:
 - I-64 west off-ramp to Route 143 (exit 243B) on November 19-21
 - I-64 east off-ramp at Route 199 west (exit 242A) on November 19-21

I-64, Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel:

- Single-lane closures as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:
 - I-64 east at the Pine Chapel overpass November 19-21 from 8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - I-64 west November 19-21 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

I-64, High Rise Bridge:

- I-64 east/west 20-minute stoppages November 18 and 19 between midnight and 4 a.m.
- I-64 east single-lane closure November 19 from 8 p.m. to 11 p.m.

I-64, Southside:

- I-64 east off-ramp to I-264 east (outside set of lanes) closed November 20 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

I-64 Reversible Roadway: The Reversible Roadway will be closed as follows:

- November 20-21 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.
- November 22 from 9 a.m. to noon.

I-664, Southside: Single-lane and ramp closures, stoppages.

- I-664 north single-lane closures and stoppages at Pughsville Road November 19 between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Pughsville Road north on-ramp to I-664 north closed November 19 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

I-264, Southside: Single-lane closure and stoppages.

- Frederick Blvd. north/south at I-264 interchange single-lane closures and 20-minute stoppages November 18 between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- I-264 east at I-64 interchange single-lane closure, inside set of lanes November 20 and 21 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- I-264 east at I-64 interchange single-lane closure and stoppages, outside set of lanes November 20 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Route 164 East/West, Portsmouth: Single-lane as follows:

- Alternating lane closures between Towne Point Road and West Norfolk Bridge
 - November 18 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - November 19-21 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - November 22 from 8 a.m. to noon.

I-564, Norfolk:

- I-564 west single-lane closure at Terminal overpass from November 19-21 from 9 p.m. to 4 a.m.
- I-564 west single-lane closure at the Runway Tunnel November 22 from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m.

Military Highway Continuous Flow Intersection, Norfolk:

- Alternating single-lane closures November 19-21 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. and from 9 a.m. to noon on November 22. One lane will remain open at all times on:
 - Military Highway between Valley Drive and Lynn Street.
 - Princess Anne Road between Sigmon Street and Military Highway.
 - Northampton Boulevard between Military Highway and past USAA Drive.
 - Robin Hood Road between Military Highway and Miller Store Road.

Turnpike Road Reconstruction Project, Portsmouth: Full closure in both directions on Frederick Boulevard at the Turnpike Intersection will be partially lifted November 21. Opening single-lane of Frederick Boulevard north and opening Turnpike Road west of the Frederick intersection. Signed detour will be in place.

Route 60 (Pocahontas Trail), James City County:

- Full closure in both directions, stoppages managed by flaggers at Skiffes Boulevard. November 20-21 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and November 22 from 9 a.m. to noon.

Courtland Interchange Project: US-58, Southampton County: Alternating lane closures in both directions on U.S. 58 as follows. One lane will remain open at all times:

- Starting at 6 a.m. November 20 and ending no later than noon November 22 between Old Bridge Road (Route 742) and Shady Brook Trail (Route 650).

I-95 North, Greensville County: Single-lane closures at the ramp to U.S. 58/U.S. 58 Business November 21 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. One lane will remain open at all times.

U.S. 301 South, Greensville County: Single-lane closures at Otterdam Road. One lane will remain open at all times:

- November 20 and 21 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Elizabeth River Tunnels/Martin Luther King Expressway: Go to [Elizabeth River Tunnels](#) for the latest project and traffic updates regarding the Downtown Tunnel (I-264), Midtown Tunnel (U.S. 58) and Route 164 MLK Expressway.
