## **HRBT, MMMBT TO REMAIN OPEN**

*Jamestown-Scotland Ferry service at reduced capacity*

**SUFFOLK** – The Hampton Roads Bridge-Tunnel and the Monitor-Merrimac Memorial Bridge-Tunnel will remain open to traffic, and the bridge-tunnels' standard speed limit of 55 mph has been restored.

Weather conditions are generally improving throughout the region as Hurricane Dorian heads out to sea.

The Jamestown-Scotland Ferry is operating at reduced capacity, due to tidal conditions, with the *Pocahontas* in service.

As the tide moves out throughout the region, VDOT is monitoring some reports of minor flooding/ponding on state-maintained roads, including I-264 east at Tidewater Drive (Exit 10) in Norfolk.
