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## TRAFFIC ALERT – LYNCHBURG DISTRICT: April 14-18, 2008

LYNCHBURG - The following highway work is scheduled **weather permitting**, in the Lynchburg District. Traffic may be restricted. **Items in italics contain new or updated information.**

### **Amherst County: Mike McCormack, Residency Administrator (434) 946-7631**

US 29 Bus. South, Carter Glass Bridge – Bridge work; there is a lane restriction -11' 10". One lane closed at a time. Est. comp. 11/08.

*US 29 Business near Lowe's – Flaggers will assist during surface repairs. Delays likely.*

Va. 652 – Road and bridge construction. Temporary traffic controls and flaggers. Est. comp. 6/09.

Va. 666 @ Little Piney River – Closed for bridge construction; detour in place. Est. comp. 4/08.

*Various – Ditching operations, debris removal, prepping for mowing and weeding operations.*

### **Appomattox County: Don Austin, Residency Administrator (434) 352-7135**

US 460 Bypass– Contractor work in right hand lane. Lane closures/delays possible.

US 460 (Appomattox to Mt. Athos) – Trash pick up. Watch for crews.

Va. 608, 669 & 750- *Pavement work may result in delays. Use caution.*

Va. 619 (620 – 633) – *Closed through mid-June for bridge replacement. Detour and advance notice signs in place.*

Va. 627 (Va. 633-601) – Road will be closed for 4-6 weeks beginning March 10 for box culvert work.

### **Buckingham County: Alan Leatherwood, P. E., Residency Administrator (434) 983-2017**

US 15 – Working shoulders; minor delays possible.

Va. 24 and other locations – Brush cutting may result in lane closures and minor delays.

Various – Responding to customer concerns and performing surface repairs. Delays and/or lane closures possible.

### **Campbell County: Don Austin, Residency Administrator (434) 352-7135**

US 501 @ Suck Creek (near Gladys) – Temporary signals and one lane during bridge replacement. Estimated completion – November 2008.

Va. 615 (646 – 600), Va. 626, 711, 718 & 823 (Yellow Branch area) and roads in Windcrest Manor, Jefferson Manor and Hughes subdivision – *Surface repairs with delays.*

Va. 24 (Va. 615 - 651) – One lane 8:30 - 6:00 for waterline placement. Est. comp. 4/18.

Va. 43 (Windy Ridge – 14<sup>th</sup> Ave.) – Construction; signs, etc. alert motorists. Est. comp. 8/3/2008.

Va. 623 (north of Va. 1594) – *Cutting and clearing of slope.*

Va. 670 & 677 (Timberlake) – *Brush cutting. Delays possible.*

Various – Addressing customer concerns.

**Charlotte County: J.D. Barkley II, P.E., Residency Administrator (434) 735-8189**

Va. 92 - Bridge closed indefinitely over Staunton River at Charlotte/Halifax County line.

Va. 607 ( Va. 609-603) – Closed approx. 10 weeks for culvert replacement.

Va. 619 (Va. 645 – 637) over Roanoke Rvr. – Closed until April 2008 for bridge replacement.

**Cumberland County: Alan Leatherwood, P.E., Residency Administrator (434) 983-2017**

Va. 621 at Amelia/Cumberland line – Bridge closed indefinitely. Detour in place.

Various – Cutting brush, performing customer service and surface repairs and cleaning ditches. Delays and/or lane closures are possible.

**Halifax County: J.D. Barkley II, P.E., Residency Administrator (434) 476-6342**

Va. 92 - Bridge closed indefinitely over Staunton River at Charlotte/Halifax County line.

Va. 360 @ Banister River –One 12’ lane; traffic signal in use. Signs and other devices alert motorists.

Berry Hill Road, South Boston – Closed 12/26/7 – 8/1/2008 at Poplar Creek for bridge replacement.

**Nelson County: Mike McCormack, Residency Administrator (434) 946-7631**

US 29 – Guardrail work at various locations. Est.completion June 2008.

Va. 56 (Bryant) – *Brush cutting with boom axe may result in minor delays. Use caution.*

Bryant – *Placement of stone on various routes. Minor delays possible.*

**Pittsylvania County: Randy Hamilton, Residency Administrator (434) 432-7214**

Va. 41 (City of Danville) – Construction; use caution. Closures and changes in traffic pattern possible. Night work to also take place from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning April 1.

Va. 875 (58 to 621) – Closed beginning 2/19 for bridge replacement. Estimated completion 5/30/08.

Brosville –Making surface repairs and installing pipe on secondary roads. Delays possible.

Gretna – *Cleaning and clearing right of way, patching potholes and making surface repairs on secondary routes. Addressing customer concerns.*

Mt. Airy – *Making surface repairs and responding to customer concerns.*

**Prince Edward County: Alan Leatherwood, P.E., Residency Administrator (434) 983-2017**

US 460/15 Bus (Farmville) – Bridge reconstruction; 11’ 0” lanes. Est. comp. fall 2008.

US 460 Business (Pamplin) – Delays are possible during crack sealing operations.

Va. 651, 658, 661 & 757 – Replacing maintenance stone. Use caution.

Va. 663 – Closed to through traffic for bridge replacement. Estimated completion – May 15, 2008.

Various – Brush cutting and litter pickup may result in delays.

*Note: **Bridge washing** will take place during the next few weeks at various locations in **Amherst, Appomattox, Campbell and Nelson Counties.***
