LYNCHBURG DISTRICT TRAFFIC ALERT October 5-9, 2009

LYNCHBURG —Highway work is scheduled weather permitting in the Lynchburg District and traffic may be restricted. Items in italics contain new or updated information. For the latest real-time traffic information, please call 511 or visit www.511Virginia.org.

Amherst County: Mike McCormack, Residency Administrator (434) 946-7631

Route 29 Business over Williams Creek (Town of Amherst) - Be alert to changes in traffic pattern during bridge rehabilitation project. Signs and signal will assist motorists in work zone.

Appomattox County: Don Austin, Residency Administrator (434) 352-7135

Route 460 West Business (Town of Appomattox) – Lane closure from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. between Route 635 and Lucy St. for sidewalk work. Est. comp. 10/9.

Route 630 & 1001 – Delays possible during surface repairs.

Concord and Stonewall areas – Use caution during boom axing operations.

Various – Crews will address customer concerns and install entrance pipe.

Buckingham County: Alan Leatherwood, PE, Residency Administrator (434) 983-2017

Route 600, 621 & 698 – Crews will cut brush. Minor delays are possible.

Various – Crews will mow, machine dirt roads, and perform ordinary bridge maintenance.

Campbell County: Don Austin, Residency Administrator (434) 947-2167

Route 460 (682 – 681), 501, 615, 623, 625, 684 & 695 – Surface work may result in closures.

Route 682 (628 – 43) – Crews will install pipe. Temporary closures possible.

Route 690 (near 617) – Delays expected during bridge project starting October 5.

Route 690 & 1574 – Crews will install. Shoulder closures likely.

Route 726 (Mt. Athos Rd.) – Lane closed during bridge deck evaluation on 10/8. Use caution.

Route 737 – Closed for approx. 2 months beginning 7/20 for pipe replacement.

Various – Crews will mow, boom axe and perform customer service.

Charlotte County: J. D. Barkley, II, PE, Residency Administrator (434) 735-8189

Route 15 over 15/360 Bypass – Bridge rehabilitation project; one lane traffic controlled by signal. Be alert to changes in traffic pattern. Est. comp. 12/09.

Route 92 – Bridge closed indefinitely over Staunton River at Charlotte/Halifax County line.

Route 619 (620 – 693) – Closed for bridge work through 11/6/2009. Detour in place.

Route 707 – Closed indefinitely due to bridge fire. Signed detour in place.

Cumberland County: Alan Leatherwood, PE, Residency Administrator (434) 983-2017

Route 45 (611-614) – 35 mph speed limit; 1 lane Mon – Sat, 7 am – 7 pm with flaggers and pilot vehicles assisting during construction. Minor delays likely. Est. comp. 5/14/10.

Route 640 – Tree trimming operations may result in delays for motorists.

Route 654, 661 & 672– *Brush cutting may result in delays. Use caution.*

Various– *Surface repairs, ordinary bridge maintenance and response to customer requests may result in minor delays.*

Route 92 – Bridge closed indefinitely over Staunton River at Charlotte/Halifax County line.

Route 602 (889 – 737)– *Road closed to through traffic for bridge replacement; approximate completion 1/15/10. Detour: 602 to 732 to 601 to 789 and back to 602.*

Pittsylvania County: Randy Hamilton, Residency Administrator (434) 432-7214

Route 58 Business West –N Main to Bryant Ave., expect possible delays through 12/31/09 due to Worsham Street Bridge project. Be alert and use caution.

Route 631 9640 – 668 – closed 6/8-10/16/09 for bridge replacement and replacement.

Route 882 over Sandy River – *Delays are possible during bridge maintenance. Beginning 10/5, motorists will stop at end of bridge and proceed when available lane is clear. Exp. comp. 11/6.*

Route 743, Brosville – *Crews will repair damaged cross line pipe. Delays possible.*

Gretna – *Crews will install entrance pipe, mow, clean/clear right of way, work shoulders, patch potholes and address customer concerns.*

Kentuck – *Crews will mow, cut brush around and perform bridge maintenance and perform customer service.*

Rondo - *Crews will make surface repairs, mow and respond to customer concerns.*

Route 15 over Route 460 – Bridge rehabilitation project. Est. comp. October 2009.

Route 460 East (mile post 262.58 to Nottoway line) – 45 mph and one lane traffic 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. during pavement rehabilitation project. Estimated completion – April 2010.

Route 696– *Crews will cut brush. Use caution.*

Various – *Crews will mow, repair surfaces, perform ordinary bridge maintenance and address customer requests. Delays are possible and caution urged.*
