## LYNCHBURG DISTRICT TRAFFIC ALERT September 7-11, 2009

LYNCHBURG —Highway work is scheduled weather permitting in the Lynchburg District and traffic may be restricted. Items in italics contain new or updated information. For the latest real-time traffic information, please call 511 or visit [www.511Virginia.org](http://www.511Virginia.org).

### **Amherst County: Mike McCormack, Residency Administrator (434) 946-7631**

Route 29 Business over Williams Creek (Town of Amherst) - Bridge rehabilitation. Be alert to changes in traffic pattern. Signs and signal will assist motorists in work zone.

Various – Watch for signs and flaggers during surface treatment operations. Use caution.

### **Appomattox County: Don Austin, Residency Administrator (434) 352-7135**

Route 642, 647, 680 & 738 possible during surface repairs.

Various – Crews will address customer concerns and install entrance pipe.

### **Buckingham County: Alan Leatherwood, PE, Residency Administrator (434) 983-2017**

Route 617 and other locations – Crews will cut brush. Use caution.

Route 823 – Surface treatment scheduled for rural addition project.

Various – Crews will patch, grade shoulders and ditches and address customer concerns.

### **Campbell County: Don Austin, Residency Administrator (434) 947-2167**

Route 29 North (692 – 686) – Ditch work may create delays. Be alert.

Route 29 – Mowing operations in Yellow Branch area. Be alert.

Route 501 (24-680) & 663 –Surface repairs/paving may result in lane/shoulder closures.

Route 682 (628 – 43) – Crews will replace mainline pipe. Temporary closures possible.

Route 737 (656 – 737) – Closed for approx. 2 months beginning 7/20 for pipe replacement.

Route 1563 – Crews will install entrance pipe. Shoulder closures likely.

Various – Crews will boom axe and do customer service.

**Charlotte County: J. D. Barkley, II, PE, Residency Administrator (434) 735-8189**

Route 15 over 15/360 Bypass – Bridge rehabilitation project; one lane traffic controlled by signal. Be alert to changes in traffic pattern. Est. comp. 12/09.

Route 92 – Bridge closed indefinitely over Staunton River at Charlotte/Halifax County line.

Route 619 (620 – 693) – Closed for bridge work through 10/2/2009. Detour in place.

Route 707 – Closed indefinitely due to bridge fire. Signed detour in place.

**Cumberland County: Alan Leatherwood, PE, Residency Administrator (434) 983-2017**

Route 45 (611 -614) – 35 mph speed limit; 1 lane Mon – Sat, 7 am – 7 pm with flaggers and pilot vehicles assisting during construction. Minor delays likely. Est. comp. 5/14/10.

Route 631, 647 & 703 – Brush cutting with a boom axe may result in delays. Use caution.

Route 600 & 690 – Surface repairs may result in minor delays.

**Halifax County: J. D. Barkley, II, PE, Residency Administrator (434) 476-6342**

Route 92 – Bridge closed indefinitely over Staunton River at Charlotte/Halifax County line.

Route 602 (889 – 737) – Road will be closed to through traffic for bridge replacement beginning 9/14 for approximately 20 weeks. Detour: 602 to 732 to 601 to 789 and back to 602.

**Nelson County: Mike McCormack, Residency Administrator (434) 946-7631**

Various – Watch for signs and flaggers during surface treatment operations. Use caution.

**Pittsylvania County: Randy Hamilton, Residency Administrator (434) 432-7214**

Route 58 Business West – N Main to Bryant Ave., expect possible delays through 12/31/09 due to Worsham Street Bridge project. Be alert and use caution.

Route 882 over Sandy River – Delays are possible during bridge maintenance.

Brosville – Crews will boom axe and patch surfaces at various locations.

Gretna – Crews will install pipe, mow, clean and clear right of way, work shoulders, patch potholes and address customer concerns.

Kentuck – Crews will mow, install driveway pipe and perform customer service and bridge maintenance. Delays are possible.

Mt. Airy – Crews will perform customer service and make surface and shoulder repairs.

Rondo – Crews will make surface repairs, patch potholes and respond to customer concerns.

**Prince Edward County: Alan Leatherwood, PE, Residency Administrator (434) 983-2017**

Route 15 over Route 460 – Bridge rehabilitation project. Est. comp. October 2009.

Route 460 East (mile post 262.58 to Nottoway line) – One lane traffic 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. during pavement rehabilitation project. Estimated. completion – April 2010.

Route 460 – Crews will repair shoulders. Be alert to lane and shoulder closures.

Route 612, 666, 683, 696 – Crews will cut brush. Use caution.

**City of Lynchburg: Don Austin, Residency Administrator, (434) 352-7135**

Route 128 – Heavy congestion, lane closure and major delays during work on Candler's Mountain Road bridge over the railroad near Mayflower Drive. Est. comp. Sept. 14.
