## **TURN LANE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT BEGINNING AT PRINCE GEORGE DRIVE AND POLE RUN ROAD IN PRINCE GEORGE**

*Improvements include a new turn lane and a turn lane extension*

**PRINCE GEORGE** — Weather permitting, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will begin work on a project to construct turn lanes at the intersection of Prince George Drive (Route 156) and Pole Run Road (Route 616) in Prince George County on Monday, June 18.

Work includes the construction of a turn lanes from Prince George Drive south to Pole Run Road and the extension of the existing turn lane from Prince George Drive north to Pole Run Road. Flagging operations will be in place during scheduled work hours.

The work is expected to be complete by late summer 2018.
