CHEWNING ROAD TO CLOSE DAILY IN HANOVER FOR UTILITY WORK

The road will be closed weekdays to through traffic; follow posted detour

HANOVER — Beginning Tuesday, March 13, Chewning Road (Route 709) will be closed weekdays from 9 a.m.-3 p.m. to through traffic at both Mountain Road (Route 33) intersections. The utility work taking place is part of an intersection improvements project at Mountain Road and Ashland Road in Hanover.

Drivers can use Mountain Road as a detour during the daily closures. There will also be alternating lanes closed from 9 a.m.-3 p.m. on both Mountain Road and Ashland Road (Route 623) for the same project. Weather permitting; the temporary detour is expected to be in place through Friday, March 16.
