## **I-95 JAMES RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT TO BEGIN IN RICHMOND** *Overnight and weekend lane closures to impact traffic*

***I-95 James River Bridge (City of Richmond)*** – The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will begin restoration work July 30 on the I-95 James River Bridge in the City of Richmond, which is expected to cause overnight and weekend traffic impacts.

The project includes general maintenance such as patching the roadway and replacing joints. The work is expected to continue through spring 2019.

“Work on the bridge will be performed during the nighttime hours to minimize the impact to drivers. However, we do expect some traffic delays and drivers are encouraged to use alternate routes,” said Robert Poutier, area construction engineer for VDOT’s Central Region.

Drivers can expect single and double lane closures during weeknights and weekends. Weeknight closures will generally be from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. and weekend closures will be from 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Updated work schedules and other project details will be posted throughout the project at [http://www.virginiadot.org/projects/richmond/i-95\\_bridge\\_work\\_in\\_richmond.asp](http://www.virginiadot.org/projects/richmond/i-95_bridge_work_in_richmond.asp)
