Vaughan Rd. (Rt. 675) to Close For Repair in Dinwiddie *The road will be closed between Fort Emory Rd. and Plantation Rd.*

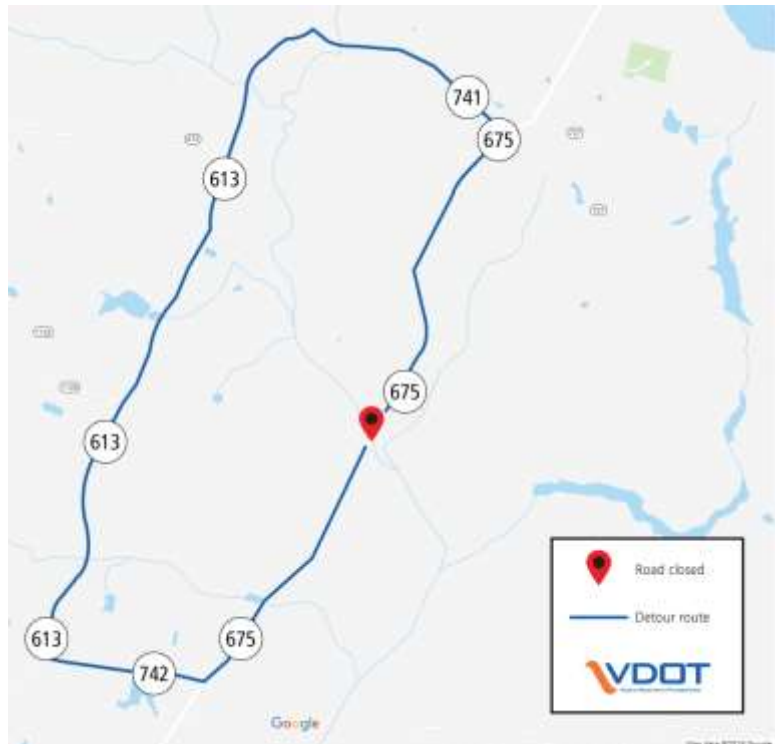
DINWIDDIE – The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) will close Vaughan Rd. (Rt. 675) over Arthur Swamp between Fort Emory Rd. and Plantation Rd. in Dinwiddie County for temporary pipe repair. The road will be closed December 3-7, 2018.

During work, drivers should follow the posted detour routes:

- **Northbound Vaughan Rd. (Route 675)** – Take Plantation Rd. (Rt. 742) west to Squirrel Level Rd. (Rt. 613) north to Fort Emory Rd. (Rt. 741) east back to Vaughan Rd. (Rt. 675).
- **Southbound Vaughan Rd. (Route 675)** – Take Fort Emory Rd. (Rt. 741) west to Squirrel Level Rd. (Rt. 613) south to Plantation Rd. (Rt. 742) east back to Vaughan Rd. (Rt. 675)

Additional work with an extended road closure is scheduled for January 2019.
