W. PATRICK HENRY ROAD (ROUTE 54) CLOSED IN HANOVER

Crews continue to make progress on storm damage repairs

SOUTH CHESTERFIELD – Repair work continues on W. Patrick Henry Rd. (Route 54) in Hanover County following May storm damage. Crews have excavated the damaged underground pipe and will soon install new concrete pipes. Work is expected to be complete by the end of summer.

The following roads damaged by May storms have been repaired and are now reopen:

- Robinson Ferry Road (Route 644) in Brunswick County
- Kings Dominion Boulevard (Route 30) in Hanover County
- Saffold Road (Route 635) in Lunenburg County
- Switchback Road (Route 605) in Lunenburg County
- Chalk Level Road (Route 655) in Mecklenburg County
- Alden Road (Route 624) in Prince George County

Repair work is weather dependent. As a reminder, motorists should not drive around or move barricades or signage.
