NORTHERN VIRGINIA MEGAPROJECTS INCLUDE:

Woodrow Wilson Bridge expansion

– The I-95/Telegraph Road interchange will widen I-95 and improve on and off ramp movements at Telegraph Road

Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project

– Phase 1 is the extension of the existing Metrorail Orange Line to Wiehle Avenue in Reston

Beltway High Occupancy Toll (HOT) lanes

– Two lanes in each direction will be added to the Capital Beltway for 14 miles from the Springfield Interchange to north of the Dulles Toll Road

High Occupancy Toll (HOT) lanes on I-95/395

– For 56 miles, one High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV)/HOT lane will be added to existing HOV lanes, and two new HOT lanes will be built from Route 234 to Massaponax (Proposed project).

I-95 widening in Fairfax and Prince William counties

– A fourth general-purpose lane will be added in each direction from Route 123 to Route 7100 (Fairfax County Parkway) for a distance of six miles. Work also includes widening 10 bridges, including two over the Occoquan River; constructing 16 retaining walls; installing storm pipe; and installing eight sound barriers.

Fairfax County Parkway extension

– The final extension of the Parkway from Rolling Road to Fullerton Road was broken into four phases. Phases I and II and a portion of Phase IV are under contract with a design-build contractor and scheduled to be completed by the end of November 2010. Federal stimulus funds were recently approved to complete Phase III and the remainder of Phase IV. The parkway project involves construction of two miles of a 4-lane divided parkway, including flyover between Chancellor Road and the Franconia-Springfield Pkwy, Fort Belvoir Engineering Proving Ground access Interchange, bridge over Accotink, construction of the Fairfax County Parkway from the existing interchanges at Rolling Road (State Route 638) to the north and Fullerton Road to the south. This proposed project runs through the western and southern portions of the Fort Belvoir Engineering Proving Ground for approximately 1.5 miles.

Take Westfields Blvd ramp toward VA-662.
Keep left at the fork in the ramp.

Turn slight Right onto Stonecroft Blvd.
