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# Notes from the Contract Engineer for April 2009

- **Change in the Prequalification Officer** - After 45 years of service to the Commonwealth of Virginia, *Roy Thacker* the Prequalification Officer has retired. Ms. Suzanne Lucas has been appointed as the Prequalification Officer. She has been Roy's backup person over the past year, so she is familiar with your accounts. We will attempt to make the transition as seamless as possible for you, so please continue to use Roy's old phone number and mailing address, and Suzanne will assist you.
- There have been several nationwide incidences reported recently where variable message signs have been hacked into. The motorist alert messages have been changed by hackers putting the public at risk. Hackers were able to gain access to the signs because the sign owners did not change the factory default password. I have attached an announcement from ADDCO that while specific to their signs, the message certainly applies to all models. Please take appropriate actions to ensure your signs are safe from misuse.
- This is an advanced notice of an impending change to the Bid Express Contractor Billing System.

On December 29<sup>th</sup>, Bid Express issued an advanced notification to subscribers regarding a contemplated change in the billing process for the bid bond validation fee that represents only a portion of the annual fee collected by the surety agencies. Many subscribers called or e-mailed our office expressing concern about the change.

It has always been our goal at Bid Express to make bidding easier and more efficient for contractors. From the calls and e-mails received, we understand that the current method of billing for bid bond validation fee is satisfactory to our subscribers. Therefore, we will **NOT** be implementing this change on April 1, 2009, as previously scheduled. The surety agents will continue to collect the bid bond fees directly from the contractors.

Bid Express is currently establishing a Customer Advisory Board to help us guide our decision making. Having this resource will ensure that we are more in tune with subscribers needs on issues such as this in the future.

- Most projects on the current advertisements are now governed by the 2007 Road and Bridge Specifications. Please be sure to examine the proposal to determine which edition applies. Under the 2007 Specifications, the Standards and Specification books are no longer supplied free of charge with the award of a project. Contractors may purchase the new 2007 edition from the plan room for \$10 each. A new edition of the Road & Bridge Standards is now available for sale for \$50.00 per set.
- You can order plans and proposals via e-mail. The order form will be available on line at [www.virginiadot.org/business/const](http://www.virginiadot.org/business/const) and will be a fill it form. Once you complete the form you may e-mail it to [vdotcoplanroom@vdot.virginia.gov](mailto:vdotcoplanroom@vdot.virginia.gov).
- If you do not purchase paper plans or proposals from the VDOT plan room, I cannot notify you of plan revisions. It is your responsibility to check in NOTICES on the VDOT advertisement page for Revisions.
- Notice that the approximate value of advertised work is included on the paper and website advertisement. This is the cash forecast estimate and **NOT** the Engineer's Estimate. It contains Engineering, State Force Work & Contingencies, as well as the construction costs. This should be used only to judge the relative size of the job.
- Electronic Plans are available during the advertisement cycle. This can help you decide whether you are interested in bidding on a job. You can look at the plans and proposal on-line before you buy paper plans on the website at [www.virginiadot.org/business/const](http://www.virginiadot.org/business/const). Under "all things advertisement" click on "instructions for utilizing the Falcon Website. Call me if you need more information.
- Use CABB (Contractor's Advertisement Bulletin Board) to ask questions about a job. Just click on the "?" on the advertisement page. It is the only way to ask questions during advertisement. You must be a plan holder to ask questions. If no questions have been asked, the question mark is **BLUE**. It will be **RED** if questions have been asked.

# Important Notice to Bidders

The Governor has determined that all commerce with the Commonwealth of Virginia will utilize one central procurement portal that is common to all agencies. It is called eVa for electronic-Virginia. It is operated under the direction of the Department of General Services (DGS). Beginning with the August 2003 advertisements, all proposals will contain a provision similar to the following:

**Section 102 eVA BUSINESS-TO-GOVERNMENT VENDOR REGISTRATION:** The eVA Internet electronic procurement solution, web site portal [www.eva.state.va.us](http://www.eva.state.va.us), streamlines and automates government purchasing activities in the Commonwealth. The portal is the gateway for vendors to conduct business with state agencies and public bodies. All vendors desiring to provide goods and/or services to the Commonwealth shall participate in the eVA Internet e-procurement solution either through the eVA Basic Vendor Registration Service or eVA Premium Vendor Registration Service. All bidders must register in eVA prior to award of any contracts. **Failure to register will result in the bid being rejected.**

- a. eVA Basic Vendor Registration Service: \$25 Annual Registration Fee **plus the appropriate order Transaction Fee specified below.** eVA Basic Vendor Registration Service includes electronic order receipt, vendor catalog posting, and on-line registration. It also includes an electronic bidding system for use for goods and services (not construction). For construction projects, firms will continue to use the Bid Express Internet bidding system.
- b. eVA Premium Vendor Registration Service: **\$25** Annual Registration Fee plus Transaction Fee **plus the appropriate order Transaction fee specified below.** eVA Premium Vendor Registration Service includes all benefits of the eVA Basic Vendor Registration Service plus automatic email or fax notification of solicitations and amendments, and ability to research eVa historical procurement data, as they become available.
- c. **For orders issued prior to July 1, 2006, the Vendor Transaction Fee is 1%, capped at a maximum of \$500 per order.**
- d. **For orders issued July 1, 2006 and after, the Vendor Transaction Fee is:**
  - i) **DMBE-certified Woman-Owned Businesses: 1%, capped at \$1,500 per order.**
  - ii) **DMBE-certified Minority-Owned Businesses: 1%, capped at \$1,500 per order.**
  - iii) **Other Businesses not specified in (i) or (ii) above: 1% capped at \$1,500 per order.**
  - iv) **DMBE-certified Small Business: 1%, capped at \$500 per order**

This provision requires firms to register with eVa and pay the annual fee. The \$25 basic fee (payable directly to eVa), should be all most contractors will need. VDOT will continue to supply all the same services that we have always supplied, including direct mailing of the monthly advertisement schedule. If you are awarded a contract, your firm will be billed a Transaction fee by eVa after your first estimate is generated. This fee is charged once for each contract awarded, and is used to defray the cost to operate the eVa system.

The eVa system is completely separate from all other bidding requirements to participate in VDOT's construction program. All contractors still must be prequalified; and firms must be enrolled in BidX, if they desire to bid electronically.

**Note: If your proposal contains the above specification, the contract will be awarded only if you are registered in eVa prior to execution of the contract.**

I understand the registration process is quickly and easily done on line. I suggest that you register at your earliest convenience to avoid Internet registration traffic.

## VDOT Work Zone Traffic Control Training Requirements

The FHWA past a final rule on Work Zone Safety and Mobility which now requires work zone safety training in the Code of Federal Regulations. Section 23 CFR 630 Subpart J (d) states “Training – States shall require that personnel involved in the development, design, implementation, operation, inspection, and enforcement of work zone related transportation management and traffic control be trained, appropriate to the job decisions each individual is required to make. States shall require periodic training updates that reflect changing industry practices and State processes and procedures.”

To meet this training requirement, and to enhance safety for workers and motorist, VDOT, through a Work Zone Safety Training Committee (WZSTC), developed training procedures, approved courses and materials, and defined instructor qualifications. The training procedures are available at the following site:

Training requirements are grouped as follows:

- **Basic Work Zone Traffic Control (WZTC)** – One day training course focused on short term maintenance type activities such as daily shoulder or lane closures, flagging operations and spot traffic control.
- **Intermediate WZTC** – Two day training course focused on long term construction type activities where review of and adjustments made to traffic control may be needed due to changing conditions.
- **Advanced WZTC** – Two day training course focused on the design of traffic control plans.

VDOT will not be providing training for the public; however, the required courses will be available through various VDOT approved private entities. Information on course offerings as well as instructor qualifications for teaching the courses is located at the following site:

Beginning with **July 2009** advertisements contracts will include language requiring compliance with this program. The program requires that at least one person on each project possess the Intermediate WZTC training, and at least one person on each construction/maintenance operation possess the Basic WZTC training. In addition, at least one person on each project design team shall possess the Advanced WZTC training.

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## NOTICE: 'HACKABLE PROGRAMMABLE MESSAGE SIGNS' REPORTS

Dear Customer,

The web-site "i-hacked.com" has posted an article on how to 'hack a programmable message sign' ([www.i-hacked.com/content/view/274/48](http://www.i-hacked.com/content/view/274/48)). ADDSCO is aware of one incident where this information has been used to alter a deployed portable changeable message sign. Statements made within this article include information on ADDSCO's default passwords; the article is not, however entirely accurate and **there are several ways to ensure your signs are protected**. Please use this as a reminder to review the policies and procedures within your company or agency to ensure that you are taking the necessary steps to secure all of your portable changeable message signs.

To be clear, the software in ADDSCO's signs has **not** been compromised; rather the default password has been publicized. Therefore, to ensure the security of your equipment, ADDSCO recommends the following:

- Physical security is a key element in the protection of portable changeable message signs, always lock the cabinets.
- As with any password-protected device, change the default password. As a reminder, instructions to change the password are attached.
- To further enhance the security of your equipment, the Hand-Held Terminal may be removed from the cabinet.

To clarify the contents of the internet article, "DOTS" **is** the default password for many ADDSCO signs, and this password should be changed. However, there are no consistent "back-door passwords" in our controllers as the article suggests. The password "DIPY" is **not** a valid password; and SHIFT/CNTRL will **not** unlock the sign without a corresponding valid password.

Our controllers employ a sophisticated algorithm to provide a method to unlock the sign in case that a password is forgotten. Should you forget your password, the controller will provide you with a key (a unique combination of letters and numbers) and ask you to call our Customer Service Group with this information. The controller changes its key regularly to ensure that the system remains secure. With this key, ADDSCO can provide you with a second, matching key that will allow you to unlock the sign. Both keys automatically expire ensuring that the same keys cannot be used repeatedly.

It is ADDCO's policy that if we receive a call from a person who claims they are with a known customers' company, we will assist them in resetting the password. In most cases, this ensures that service is restored quickly and correctly. However, this does create a possibility for problems if an unauthorized person misrepresents his identity. Therefore, in light of the publicity this notice has received, ADDCO will create and maintain a secure access program, in which you can enroll free of charge. If you do not elect to participate in this process, you may leave your signs exposed to potential security threats if signs are left unlocked or cut open. To enroll in the program, please contact ADDCO support with the serial numbers of the equipment you would like added to the program.
