NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby authorizes the Virginia Department of Transportation, acting by and through the Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner, to enter into cooperative agreements with the State of Maryland and the District of Columbia to provide funding for the Washington Metropolitan Traveler Information Services project.
