

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, May 3, 1938.

On the morning of May 3rd, 1938, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Wm. H. East, S. W. Rawls and J. F. Wycor, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the minutes of the meeting of March 30th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Wycor, that the Commission allocate \$500.00 per mile construction funds to the City of Bristol for 1937-38 and for 1938-39 to be expended for new construction on Routes 11, 19 and 56 in the city. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission allocate \$500.00 per mile construction funds for 1937-38 to the City of Roanoke to be applied on Routes 11 and 116 in the city. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission allocate \$600.00 per mile construction funds for 1937-38 to the City of Williamsburg, to be expended on old Route 60 for the extension of the work for which funds were allowed in 1936. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wycor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the sick leave of S. B. Jarrell, Senior Highway Equipment Operator, be extended 30 days with pay from December 11th, 1937. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the sick leave of Mrs. Gillie Nuckolls, Filing Clerk, be extended 17 days with pay from March 24th. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wycor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the sick leave of E. M. Michie, Mechanic, be extended from February 16th to 28th inclusive, with pay. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the sick leave of C.A. Smith, Junior Mechanic, be extended from March 4th to 16th inclusive with pay. Motion carried.

Smith, on Project WPMH 1113 D, Route 250, City of Charlottesville, be granted in the sum of \$581.71, for taking up concrete sidewalk and concrete anchor blocks, as recommended by the Chief Engineer. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wycor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm award of contract for insurance on automobiles and trucks for the period from noon April 20th, 1938 to noon April 20th, 1939, to the second low bidder, the Lumbermans Mutual Casualty Company of Chicago, Illinois. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the application for permit from Mr. H. D. White, Fordwick, to construct steps on the right of way of Route 42 just west of Craigs ville, be turned down. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wyszor, that the Chairman be instructed to make an investigation of the construction on Route 60 across Budee Inlet and the possible cost of a seawall to sustain the road at this point. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the usual number of summer students be taken on this year for summer work. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the policy be adopted of giving free of cost one county map to any individual and charging ten cents for each additional map. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the speed limit through construction zones be changed from 15 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. East, that the organization as shown on chart for the Drafting Division, submitted with report of Committee dated April 27th to the Chief Engineer, be adopted and approved, to take effect immediately and be fully installed by July 1st, 1938. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the location of Route 25 between Wise and Norton, as adopted by the Commission, be confirmed if the right of way can be provided; if not, the same be moved and a new relocation be investigated. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that sufficient amount be taken from Project 856, Route 60, Mariners Museum-West, to do the work on Route 60, Newport News-North, approximately \$5,000.00. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that action on suggestions of the Roanoke and Salem Chambers of Commerce for certain projects in the Salem District be postponed and the Chairman instructed to make a study and survey sufficient to give the Commission accurate information as to costs. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. East, that report made by the Engineering Division in regard to development of Route 100 as a through route be approved, and that a survey be made so that this can be done when funds are available. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the following residency offices be erected in order named: King George, Halifax, Bedford, Louisa, Warrenton, Lurey, Edinburg, Dillwyn, Pincastle, Rocky Mount and Lebanon. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyzor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that in lieu of check a note of the Town of Urbanna be accepted for work to be done on certain streets as specified in letter of April 26th from Mr. E. H. Cunningham, Jr., Resident Engineer, note payable December 1st of this year, 1938. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that no inspection charge be made for permits to lay subsurface wires on the secondary system. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that offer of \$12,000.00 for the Twiggs Ferry and holdings by the ferry people be turned down, as the value placed on this by the Commission is based on the value of the equipment and not the earning power. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission make the following transfer of funds to the Urbanna Creek Bridge on Route 227; From Route 14, Caroline,

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the State highway mileage in the Town of Vinton be corrected, decreasing this 0.03 mile and making the total within the Town 1.42 miles. Motion carried.
