

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Fredericksburg, July 27, 1929.

The State Highway Commission of Virginia met in Fredericksburg in the High School on July 27th, at ten o'clock, as per special notice, and gave a public hearing to those interested in the two proposed locations for the bridge across the Rappahannock River, one on Lafayette Avenue and the other near Falmouth.

Mr. Thomas Lomax Hunter represented the petitioners for the proposed bridge at Lafayette Avenue, and Mr. C. O'Connor Goolrick represented the city and the people who wish it constructed at Falmouth.

After discussions of some two and a half hours, the meeting adjourned, the Commission taking the matter under advisement.
