

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Orange, September 29, 1932.

On the morning of September 29th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. Wade E. Massie, Secretary, H. G. Gilmer and Wm. H. East, met in the Court House at Orange, Virginia, and held a public hearing on the classification of roads in the Secondary System for the Culpeper District.

Representatives from all of the counties in the District, that were present, were heard; after which the Commission transacted the following business.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the bids on Route 10, Project F361 I and F308 J, 0.08 Mi. E. WCL Marion-1.5 Mi. W. WCL Marion, and 6.0 Mi. E. Washington County Line-7.5 Mi. E. Washington County Line, be rejected, as the allocation in Spyzh County is to be spent on Route 115. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the bids on Route 11, Project F738 AB5,4, 1.7 Mi. E. ECL Lebanon-0.22 Mi. E. ECL Lebanon, and Bridges over Big Cedar Creek and Mile Creek, be rejected, and the allocation transferred to Route 26, Wytheville-South, as the rights of way on this section have not been secured. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F661 CB2, Route 110, 0.79 Mi. N. Russell County Line-Hansonville, to the low bidder, Jim Frank, Glinchport, Va., at his bid of \$14,541.15, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$889.00 for guard rail; \$234.76 for gravel rights; \$2,146.85 for surface treatment and \$945.00 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$21,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F206D, Route 11, 2.59 Mi. E. Claypool Hill-1.55 Mi. E. Claypool Hill, to the low bidder, Jim Frank, Glinchport, Va., at his bid of \$21,868.82, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,574.50 for surface treatment; \$508.00 for outside slope stakes and \$726.00 for guard rail, making a total of approximately \$27,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F748A, Route 15, 0.22 Mi. E. Powhatan County Line-5.37 Mi. W. Powhatan County Line, to the low bidder, Peacock and Martin, Summerfield, N.C., at their bid of \$51,808.68, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,807.00 for guard rail; \$1,008.74 for soil rights; \$9,249.90 for surface treatment and \$2,078.75 for outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$49,000. chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F88 GRB, Route 31, Stafford Court House-1.8 Mi. N. Cranes Corner; and Bridge over Anasnek Creek, to the low bidder, Guilford Construction Company, Inc., Greensboro, N.C., at their bid of \$144,228.12, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,000.00 for work outside slope stakes, and \$4,000.00 for subgrade treatment, making a total of approximately \$164,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project 6681 DB4, Route 48, 0.49 Mi. W. ECL Stony Creek-Dismiddle County Line; and Bridge over Sappony Creek, to the low bidder, Haffin Construction Co., Richmond, Va., at their bid of \$37,418.08, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$891.80 for guard rail; \$884.74 for soil rights; \$8,179.05 for surface treatment and \$1,873.25 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$52,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F562C, Route 10, 1.28 Mi. E. ECL Salem-ECL Salem, to the low bidder, C. L. Tinsley, Roanoke, Va., at his bid of \$20,366.14, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$610.50 for guard rail; \$3,584.79 for surface treatment and \$195.25 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$27,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project F7480, Route 13, 5.57 Mi. N. Powhatan County Line-Powhatan C. H., to the low bidder, B. F. Hester, Greensboro, N.C., at his bid of \$23,717.47, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,892.50 for guard rail; \$928.89 for soil rights; \$8,530.50 for surface treatment and \$1,919.25 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$39,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Commissioner.
