The State Highway Commission met in special session at 4 P.M., December 26th, 1919, in the office of the State Highway Commissioner, Room 505 Lyric Building.

All members present.

Upon recommendation of the Highway Commissioner the Commission designated Henry L. Higginbotham of Henrico, Va. as special policeman to enforce traffic regulations, recently adopted by the Commission, to govern traffic on State Highway No. 1 between Henrico and Karamees.

On motion duly seconded the minutes of the meeting of December 15, 16, 17, 18, and 19th, were read and approved, and the Chairman authorized to sign same as correct.

There being no further business before the Commission, motion was made to adjourn to meet again on December 27th. The motion was unanimously adopted.
