

Route 15/17/29 Warrenton Southern Interchange Fauquier County

Citizen Information Meeting:

You are invited to attend a citizen information meeting for the Route 15/17/29 project on **Tuesday, November 13, 2018** from **5-7 p.m.** in “The Barn” at Lord Fairfax Community College, 6480 College Street, Warrenton, VA. Dewberry Engineers, Shirley Contracting Company and VDOT staff will discuss the project before construction begins. A brief presentation will be delivered at 5:30 p.m.

Overview:

The project will replace the current at-grade intersection on Route 15/17/29 at Business Route 15/17/29 with a grade-separated interchange. The interchange design will remove the existing traffic signal on Route 15/17/29, allowing free flow of through traffic. Motorists on Route 15/17/29 will use ramps to access Business Route 15/17/29 and Route 880 (Lord Fairfax Drive), which will cross Route 15/17/29 on a new overpass with roundabouts at each end. A park and ride facility will also be constructed southeast of the interchange. Construction will begin in late 2018 and the interchange will be complete in early winter 2020.



The new bridge over Route 15/17/29 will carry two lanes of traffic and includes a shared use path.

Benefits:

This interchange configuration will improve safety and reduce congestion by allowing traffic to keep moving through the intersection. The grade-separated interchange will allow traffic to flow without traffic signals.

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
