Thank you for attending tonight's Location Public Hearing for the I-95 Rappahannock River Crossing (RRC). The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), has completed an Environmental Assessment (EA) to evaluate alternatives and potential environmental consequences of the proposed RRC project on Interstate 95, located in Spotsylvania County, Stafford County and the city of Fredericksburg.

The proposed I-95 RRC would add collector-distributor lanes parallel to the general purpose lanes between Exit 133 (Route 17) in Stafford County and Exit 130 (Route 3) in Fredericksburg as well as possible modifications to the interchanges.

The purpose of tonight's meeting is:

- To share information on the study process and the status.
- To obtain comments on the EA document.



Please examine the information presented tonight, ask questions, and provide any comments or suggestions you have. Your input is important and is needed as part of the environmental review process.
