Project Overview



U.S. 501 and Route 610 intersection

Anticipated Cost – Approx. \$20.1 million

Purpose – to construct passing lanes, widen shoulders and adjustment vertical alignment

From – 0.975 miles south of Route 610

To – 0.956 miles north of Route 610

Total length – 1.9320 miles
