GILBERT'S CORNER:

It rained again last night, it's raining again today and I cannot remember a spring that has seen as much rain. I think we have come up with a cure to droughts...detour traffic and build a roundabout. [Weather](#).

At Roundabout #1 (Routes 15/50 intersection) the contractor is working on the southern portion of the roundabout. Should be able to see the circle taking shape. The contractor is pouring curb and gutters.

At Roundabout #3 (Watson Road) the contractor has much of the curb and gutter in place, [and](#) the center island has been formed, installing drainage and wiring for the overhead lighting.

At Roundabout #4 (Route 15/Connector Road intersection) the contractor has paved the roundabout and installed the brick pavers for the truck apron. Building the foundations of the overhead lighting and began paving the roadway towards Roundabout #1.

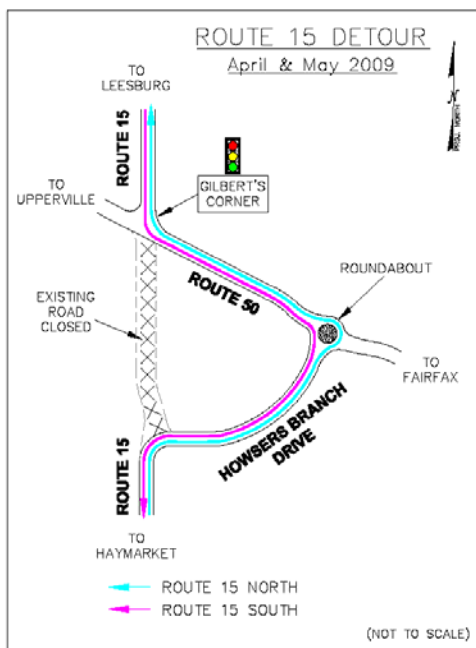

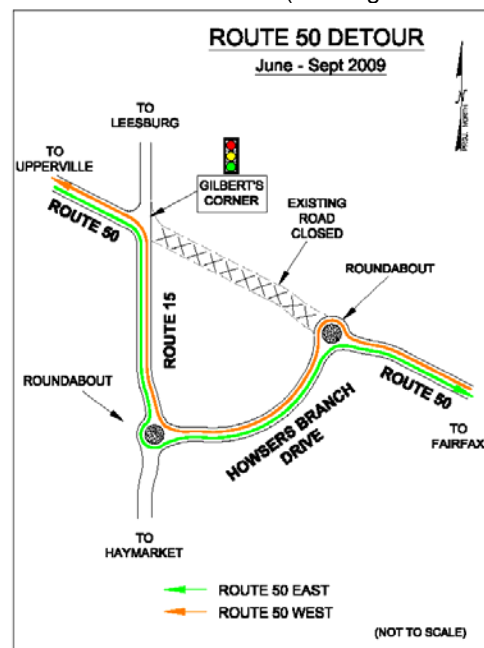
At the same time we will be closing Route 50 between Roundabout #2 (Route 50/Howser Branch Drive) and the traffic signal at Gilbert's Corner.

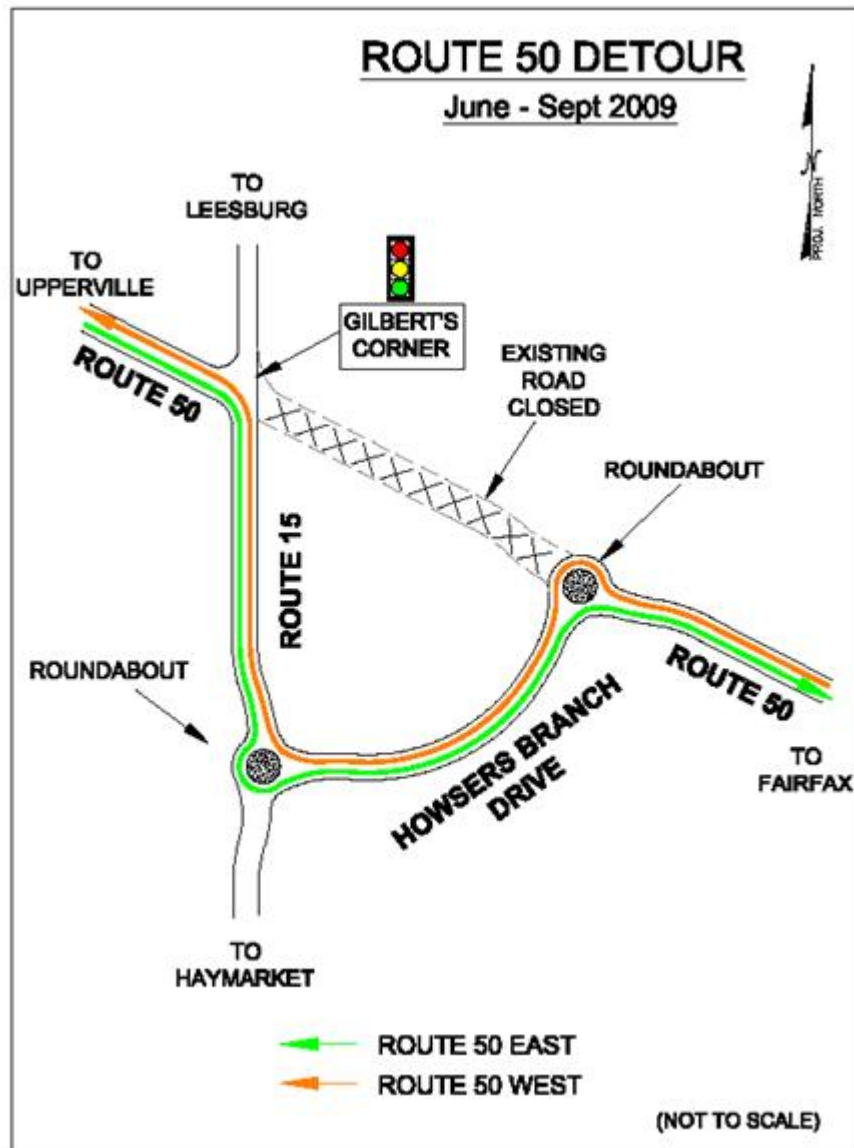

As we advised last week a new traffic pattern is coming this week.

Between the morning and evening rush hours July 1, 2009, the contractor will be reversing the current detour at Gilberts Corner. A traffic signal technician will be on site to adjust the traffic signal timing to maximize the traffic flows.

The biggest impact is expected for Wednesday's evening rush hour will be to Route 50 Westbound traffic and Thursday's morning rush hour for Northbound Route 15 traffic as motorists adjust to the new pattern.
