Repaving operations ongoing along Route 50 from Aldie to Arcola.

Superior Paving working for VDOT Maintenance has been working steadily day and night to mill and overlay sections of the Route 50 Westbound four lane section from Arcola to Lenah. Also sections of the Route 50 two lane highway have been repaved from Lenah to Cobb Road west of Aldie.

GILBERT'S CORNER:

Roundabout #1: The roundabout is starting to take shape as you can see where the contractor has constructed the eastern segment of this roundabout. The contractor has also been placing base stone and paving the roadway between Roundabout #1 and Roundabout #2. The contractor continues work on the overhead lighting. The contractor has been working on Route 15 section North of the Gilberts Corner intersection.

At Roundabout #3 (Watson Road) the contractor continues the work of demolishing the sections of old Route 50 that have been abandoned with the opening of the new roadway sections. This area will be restored to a natural environment.

In the next few weeks, the contractor will be preparing for the opening of the Route 50 section that is now under reconstruction and removing the traffic signal at Roundabout #1. All four roundabouts will be operational soon but some sections will still be under construction.

Please be careful and patient when approaching work zones.

Repaving operations ongoing along Route 50 from Aldie to Arcola.

Route 50 has been getting a new look over the past few weeks as Superior Paving has been milling off the old cracked pavement and putting down new pavement. The sections paved will tie into the current Gilberts Corner project and next year's Aldie project.

GILBERT'S CORNER:

Roundabout #1: This roundabout will be opening in the next few weeks. The traffic signals will be coming down and Route 50 will be reopened between Roundabouts #1 and #2. No more detours.

With the opening of all four roundabouts, motorists should see improved traffic flows and shorter delays during rush hour.

All work on the center circle will not be complete but it will be functional. Current work includes installation of curb and gutter, ditches, drainage pipes, pavement, signs and top soil. Work will continue over the next months as we still have to finish truck aprons, lighting, landscaping, paving, three more splitter islands, signs, pavement markings, etc.

At Roundabout #4: Work to be completed includes two more splitter islands, completing the truck apron, landscaping, lighting and signs.

Roundabout #3 (Watson Road) Lane Construction is working to restore the old Route 50 roadway to a natural environment and work on the entrance into the Mount Zion Historical Church.

Please be careful and patient when approaching work zones.

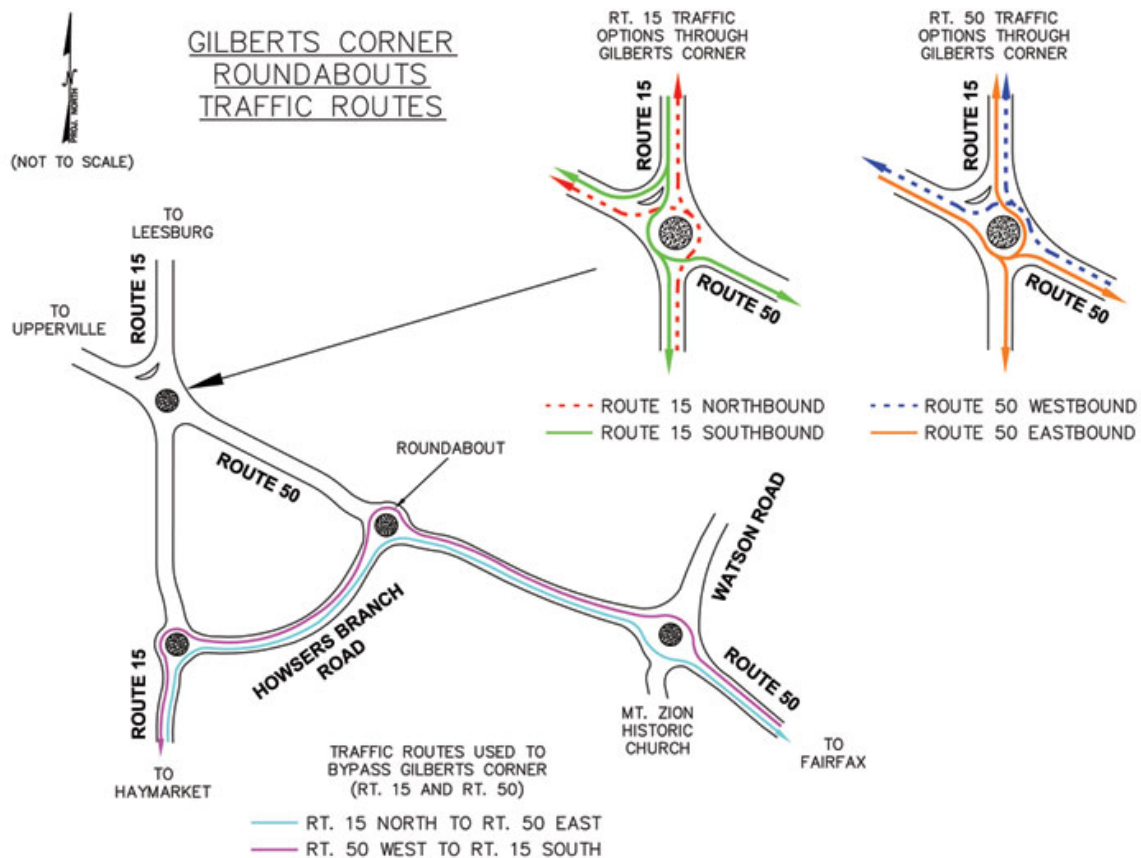

GILBERT'S CORNER: New traffic pattern - The current Route 50 Detour will be re-opened next week

Roundabout #1: This roundabout will be in operation by mid-week as the traffic signals will be coming down and Route 50 will be reopened between Roundabouts #1 and #2. No more detours but there will be lane closures during non-peak hours.

With the opening of all four roundabouts, motorists should see improved traffic flows and shorter delays during rush hour. (See attached sketch)



The contractor will be milling, paving, installing pavement markings and signs along with the many other activities to bring about this major milestone on the project.
