- Proposed highway between Route 50 and Route 606 to **provide access to the western side of Dulles Airport** and future Metro stations (VDOT's Environmental Assessment and Location Study)
- The proposed **Manassas National Battlefield Park Bypass** (the National Park Service and Federal Highway Administration's Environmental Impact Statement and Location Study)
