

## **Extension of Pacific Boulevard Loudoun County**

**Find out** about the proposed construction of a 0.61 mile roadway on new location to connect the existing sections of Pacific Boulevard. The new roadway will begin at Autoworld Drive (the northern terminus) and end at Severn Way. The facility will provide four 12-foot travel lanes, a variable-width median up to 16-feet wide, curb and gutter, and structures to carry the proposed road over the Washington & Old Dominion Railroad Regional Park (W&ODRRP) and across Cabin Branch. A 10-foot wide shared-use path and a sidewalk will be provided, along with connectors to the paved W&ODRRP trail. In conjunction with these roadway improvements turn lanes will be provided at several intersecting roadways.

**Review** the project plans depicting the new roadway alignment and major design features and the Environmental Assessment (EA) at VDOT's, Northern Virginia District office located at 14685 Avion Parkway in Chantilly, telephone number (703) 383-2000 or at the Leesburg Residency office located at 41 Lawson Road, S.E., south of Route 7, in Leesburg, telephone (703) 737-2000 or TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to assure the appropriate personnel are available to answer your questions.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is provided in the EA. The public is also hereby notified of the Federal Highway Administration's intent to issue Section 4(f) de minimis findings with respect to the project's involvements with the publicly owned parkland and historic property of the W&ODRRP and Washington & Old Dominion Railroad Historic District, respectively, as provided for in Section 6009 of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users. Information on these involvements are also included in the EA. Written comment on the EA should be sent to Mr. James C. Zeller, P.E., at the address below on or before **August 15, 2007**.

**If your location and design concerns** cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request on or before **July 31, 2007**, to:
