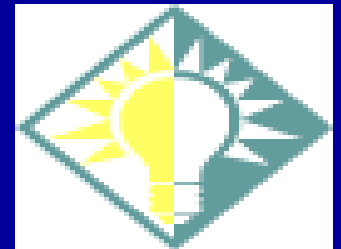

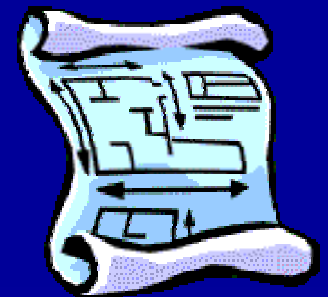
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Recent Project History

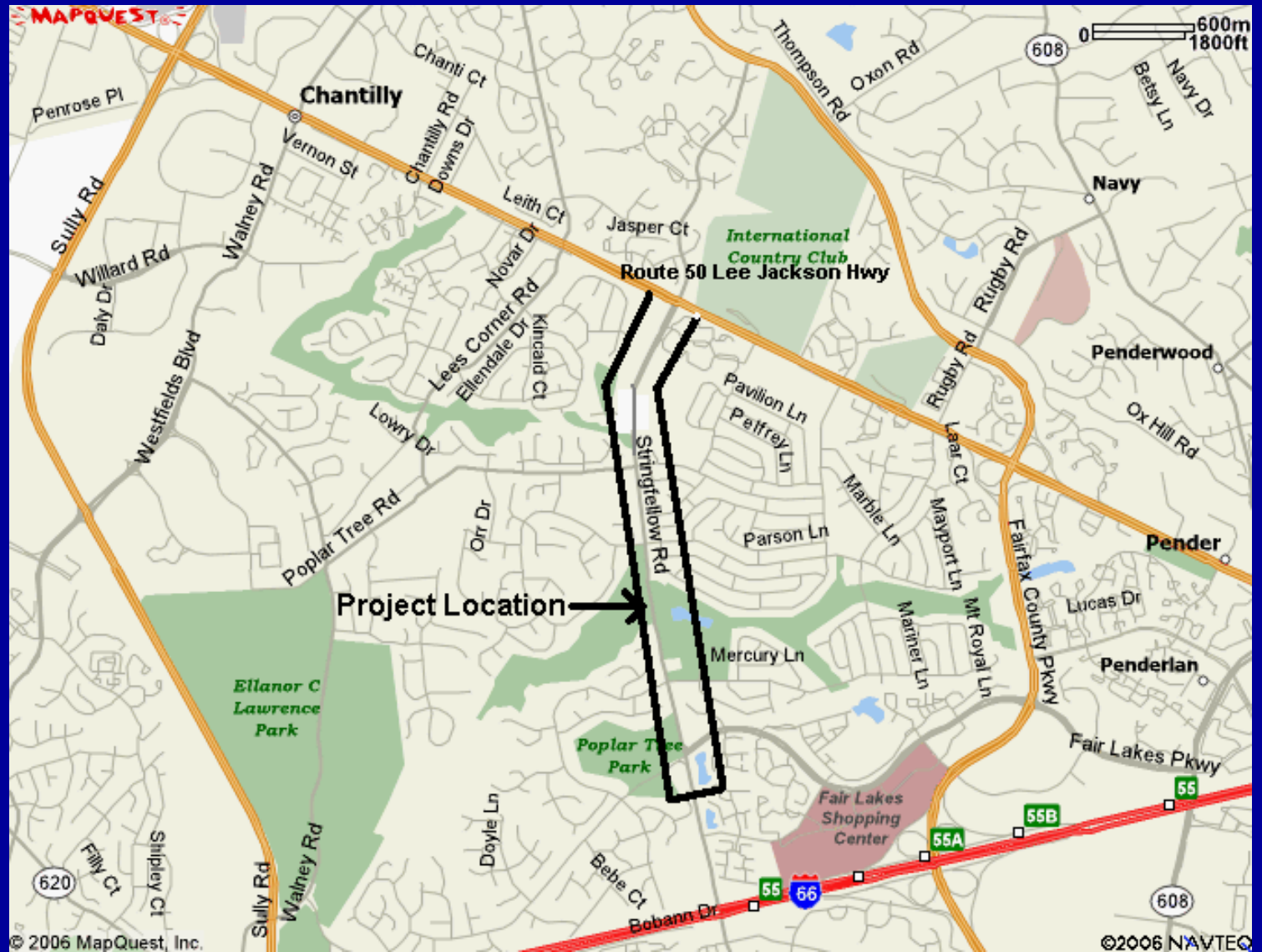

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Project Location Map

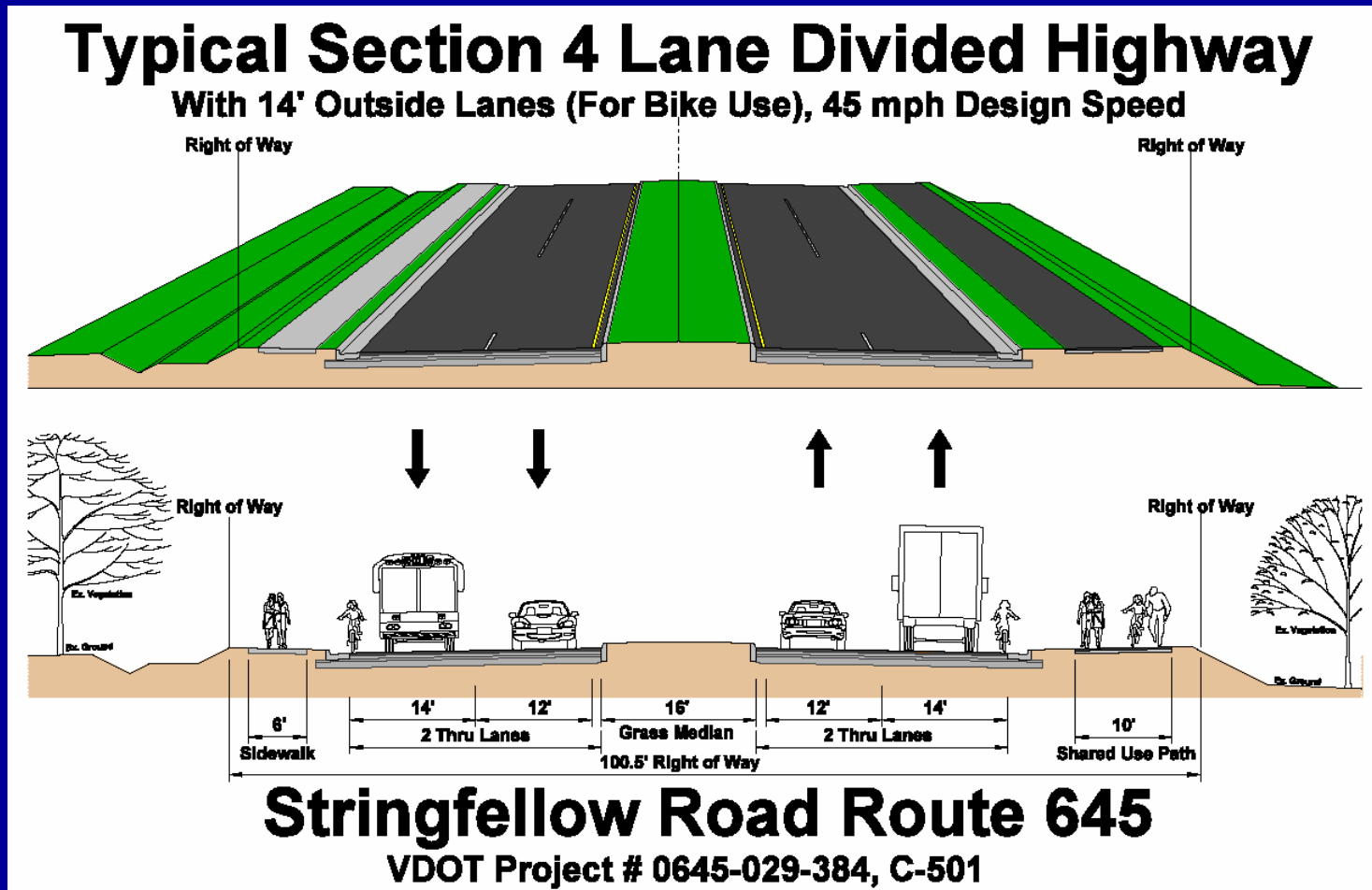

Design Considerations

- Existing homes & properties
- Parks & Library
- Schools & School Children
- Utilities
- Crossovers
- Pedestrians & Bicyclists
- Storm Water
- Wildlife Crossing @ Big Rocky Run

Proposed Typical Section



Design Elements include:

- Five foot wide sidewalk
- Ten foot wide shared-use path
- 14' wide curb lane
- Storm Water Management facilities
- Critter Crossing

Final Design – Unresolved Issues

- School Bus Access at Rocky Run MS
- Connector Road for Chantilly Library
- Final Storm Water Management Design
- Greenbriar Civic Assn /Greenbriar Park– Interparcel Connector
- Pedestrian Crossing @ Park
- November Bond Referendum

Estimated Project Cost

Total cost estimate = \$36 million

Cost is estimated in 2011 dollars
