

Blackburn Road at Rippon Boulevard Traffic Signal Prince William County

Find out about plans to install a new traffic signal at the intersection of Blackburn Road and Rippon Boulevard. Plans also include pavement resurfacing and restriping, which will allow for the restoration of the turn lanes on Rippon Boulevard, and pedestrian improvements.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Ms. Claudia Llana, P.E., Virginia Department of Transportation, at the above address on or prior to March 3, 2017. If upon receiving public comments it is deemed necessary to hold a public hearing, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.

Under an agreement with the Federal Highway Administration, preparation of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion is anticipated to comply with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and 23 CFR 771. In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places will be included with the environmental document. Appropriate studies will be undertaken to evaluate other potential effects of the proposed project on environmental resources.
