PORTION OF ROUTE 625 TO CLOSE IN BATH COUNTY

STAUNTON – Route 625 (River Road) at 0.50 mile south of the intersection of Route 624 (West Minister Road), has been closed due to a fill embankment section failure. The road will be closed to thru traffic 24 hours-a-day.

No estimate for reopening the road is available.

Signs will be posted.

Motorists are advised to use alternate routes.

The VDOT Staunton District serves Frederick, Shenandoah, Clarke, Warren, Page, Rockingham, Augusta, Highland, Rockbridge, Alleghany and Bath counties.
