## **TRAFFIC ALERT FOR JULY 2-6, 2018**

### *Highway Work Zones in the Staunton District*

**VDOT will suspend most highway work zones and lift most lane closures on interstates and other major roads in Virginia from noon Tuesday, July 3, until noon Thursday, July 5.**

**STAUNTON** – The following is a list of highway work that may affect traffic in the Staunton transportation district during the coming weeks. The Staunton district consists of 11 counties from the Alleghany Highlands to the northern Shenandoah Valley: Alleghany, Bath, Rockbridge, Highland, Augusta, Rockingham, Page, Shenandoah, Frederick, Clarke and Warren.

Scheduled work is subject to change due to inclement weather and material supplies. Motorists are advised to watch for slow-moving tractors during mowing operations. When traveling through a work zone, be alert to periodic changes in traffic patterns and lane closures.

**(NEW)** or **(UPDATE)** indicates a new entry or a revised entry since last week's report.

### **ALLEGHANY COUNTY**

#### **INTERSTATE 64**

**Mile marker 31 to 28**, westbound – Alternating lane closures for milling, paving and pavement marking. Monday-Saturday through July 6 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

#### **PRIMARY ROADS**

**Various roads** – Flagger traffic control for mowing and pavement patching at various locations. Monday to Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

#### **SECONDARY ROADS**
