## TRAFFIC ALERT FOR MAY 14-18, 2018

### *Highway Work Zones in the Staunton District*

**STAUNTON** – The following is a list of highway work that may affect traffic in the Staunton transportation district during the coming weeks. The Staunton district consists of 11 counties from the Alleghany Highlands to the northern Shenandoah Valley: Alleghany, Bath, Rockbridge, Highland, Augusta, Rockingham, Page, Shenandoah, Frederick, Clarke and Warren.

Scheduled work is subject to change due to inclement weather and material supplies. Motorists are advised to watch for slow-moving tractors during mowing operations. When traveling through a work zone, be alert to periodic changes in traffic patterns and lane closures.

**(NEW)** or **(UPDATE)** indicates a new entry or a revised entry since last week's report.

### ALLEGHANY COUNTY

#### **INTERSTATE 64**

**(NEW) Mile marker 7 to 21**, eastbound and westbound – Overnight mobile lane closures for bridge sweeping. May 14-18 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.

**Mile marker 29 to 36**, eastbound – Alternating lane closures for milling, paving and line painting. Monday – Friday through May 18 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

**(NEW) Mile marker 35 to 39**, eastbound – Right lane closures for pavement marking. May 12-June 1 from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

#### **PRIMARY ROADS**

**(UPDATE) Route 60** (Midland Trail/Dunlap Creek Road) – Flagger traffic control for pavement marking and shoulder work from Covington city limits to I-64 interchange at exit 10 (Callaghan). Through May 18 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

**Various roads** – Flagger traffic control for brush cutting and tree removal at various locations. Monday to Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**Route 696** (Selma-Low Moor Road) – Occasional flagging operations as needed near Route 1101 (Winterberry Avenue) and I-64 for intersection improvements. Estimated project completion summer 2018.
