

FOURTH OF JULY 2018

VDOT will lift most lane closures for holiday travel from noon Tuesday, July 3 until noon Thursday, July 5. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in the following locations:

Alleghany County

I-64 – Milling and paving eastbound between mile markers 32 and 35. Single lane closure.

Amherst County

Route 29 Business – Replacing median barrier. Lane closures will occur.

Appomattox County

Route 460 Bypass – Recycling current surface and overlaying. Temporary lane closure; concrete barrier in place. Width restriction is 11 feet.

Bland County

I-77 – A lane closure on I-77 north at East River Mountain Tunnel will be removed over the holiday; however, WVDOT will resume work July 9 and the lane closure in Virginia will be back in place. The lane closure will ensure traffic moves smoothly through the tunnel. Information about suggested detour routes is available on [VDOT's website](#). Brunswick County

Route 1 – Repairing bridge over Great Creek. Traffic restricted to one lane, controlled by a temporary traffic signal.

Buckingham County

Route 20 – Widening pavement, installing rumble strips and replacing guardrail. Traffic controlled by flaggers and pilot vehicle. Temporary lane closures possible.

Botetourt County

- **I-81** – Improving Exit 150 interchange. Lane closures possible. Off-ramp at Exit 150A narrowed by barrier wall and is right-turn only onto Route 11 south. Shoulder closures in place throughout the area. Signs and message boards in place.

- **Route 220** – Making safety improvements between Eagle Rock and Iron Gate. Lane and shoulder closures with flaggers are possible. Speed limit reduced to 45 mph in work zone.

Campbell County

Route 24 – Constructing roundabout at intersection with Route 646. Truck traffic over 44 feet in length restricted. Temporary lane closures possible.

Fredericksburg

I-95 – Improving interchange at Exit 130 (Route 3). All travel lanes open; concrete barriers in place along the shoulder northbound and southbound in work zone. Be alert for new traffic signal and traffic pattern at the exit ramp from I-95 south to Route 3 west.

Halifax County

Route 58 – Rehabilitating westbound bridge over Lawson Creek. Lane closure; width restriction is 11 feet 6 inches.

Lynchburg

- **Liberty Mountain Drive** – Constructing roundabout. Ramp to eastbound Route 460 closed.
- **Odd Fellows Road**
 - Widening road for new interchange. New roundabout at intersection with Mayflower Drive in place. Sidewalk and shared use path work underway.
 - Completing paving, entrances, and utility work associated with road reconstruction. Temporary lane closures may occur.

Montgomery County

Route 460 – Making safety improvements on Route 460 (North Main Street) in Blacksburg. Lane and shoulder closures possible.

Newport News/Williamsburg

I-64 – Widening interstate. Speed limit reduced to 55 mph in work zone in both directions.

Northampton County

Route 642 – Reconstructing roadway. Detour in place.

Pittsylvania County

Route 29 Chatham Bypass – Completing work on northbound median shoulder. Lane closures in place.

Prince Edward County

Route 460 – Milling and paving westbound during overnight hours. Lane closures in place.

Pulaski/Montgomery County

I-81 – Replacing northbound bridge over the New River at the Pulaski/Montgomery County line. Shoulders closed between mile markers 103 and 105. Speed limit reduced to 60 mph in work zone.

Rockingham County

Route 257 – Replacing bridge over Dry River. Single-lane traffic is controlled by temporary signal. Width restriction is 13 feet.

Rockingham/Page County

Route 602 – Rehabilitating bridge over South Fork Shenandoah River. Temporary signals control traffic. Width restriction is 10 feet.

Scott County

Route 23 – Replacing eastbound bridge over North Fork Holston River in the Wadlow Gap area. Traffic restricted to one lane both directions, sharing the westbound bridge.

Shenandoah/Warren County

Route 11 – Replacing bridge over Cedar Creek at the Shenandoah/Warren County line. Traffic in both directions reduced to one lane, sharing the southbound bridge. Northbound traffic uses right lane of new bridge. Southbound traffic uses right lane of old bridge.

Spotsylvania County

I-95 – Improving the Exit 118 (Thornburg) interchange and replacing the I-95 overpass. All travel lanes open; concrete barriers in place along the shoulder northbound and southbound in work zone.

Stafford County

I-95 – Improving interchange at Exit 140 (Courthouse Road). All travel lanes open; concrete barriers in place along the shoulder northbound and southbound in work zone.

Washington County

I-81

- Reconstructing interchange at Exit 14, and improving Old Jonesboro Road beneath interstate. Speed limit through work zone on I-81 reduced to 60 mph.
- Reconstructing two interstate bridges over Halls Bottom Road near Exit 10. Speed limit through work zone reduced to 60 mph.
- Rehabilitating Route F310 bridge at Exit 10. Traffic signals control one-way traffic on Route F310; large trucks must detour using Exit 7 or Exit 13. Nighttime lane closures on I-81 near Exit 10.

Wythe County

I-77/I-81 overlap – High traffic volumes could slow or stop vehicles through this eight-mile stretch. Be alert for delays on I-77 north at the I-81 merge due to work to add a merge lane.
