

EASTER 2019

VDOT will lift most lane closures for holiday travel from noon Friday, April 19 until noon Tuesday, April 23. However, motorists may encounter semi-permanent work zones or travel delays in the following locations:

Botetourt County

Route 11 – Replacing two existing bridges on Route 11 over Tinker Creek at Route 838 (Vista Drive) and Route 1039 (Gibson Lane). Lane closures and new traffic pattern in place. Width restriction in place.

Route 220 – Making safety improvements between Eagle Rock and Iron Gate. Lane and shoulder closures with flaggers are possible. Width restriction of 12 feet. Speed limit reduced to 45 mph in work zone.

Route 220 – Replacing pipe on Route 220 north just north of Fincastle. Traffic reduced to one lane in both directions. Width restriction of 12 feet. Speed limit reduced to 35 mph in work zone.

Campbell County

Route 29 Business – Replacing bridge over river and railroad in Altavista. Signed detour in place.

Route 501 at Route 633 – Constructing left and right turn lanes. Temporary lane closures possible.

City of Chesapeake

I-64 Southside Widening and High Rise Bridge Project – Widening interstate between I-264/Bowers Hill and Battlefield Boulevard. Speed limit reduced to 55 mph in work zone in both directions.

Chesterfield County/Henrico County

I-295 – Restoring Varina-Enon Bridge over the James River. Left lanes closed in both directions.

City of Covington

Route 3605 – Completing roadway improvements on South Durant Road/West Jackson Street between Willis Avenue and Thacker Avenue. Detour in place.

City of Danville

Route 29 – Making emergency repairs to Route 29 bypass over Barkers Branch due to storm damage. Changes in traffic pattern likely.

Fauquier County

Route 15/17/29 – Constructing grade-separated interchange. Narrowed lanes and shoulder closures in both directions, south of Warrenton, near Business Route 15/17/29 and Route 880 (Lord Fairfax Road).

City of Hampton

I-64 – Rehabilitating bridge on I-64 east over Armistead Avenue (Route 134). Northbound LaSalle Avenue on-ramp to I-64 east, I-64 east auxiliary lane, and east or westbound Armistead Avenue will be closed to traffic.

City of Lynchburg

Liberty Mountain Drive – Constructing roundabout. Ramp to Route 460 east closed.

Odd Fellows Road – Completing paving, entrances and utility work associated with road reconstruction. Bridge over railroad closed for demolition; temporary lane closures may occur.

Mecklenburg County

Route 1 – Repairing bridge at the I-85 interchange. Right lane closed northbound.

Montgomery County

I-81 – Replacing northbound and southbound bridges over Route 8 at exit 114. Shoulders closed with median barriers in place from mile marker 113 to 114. Speed limit reduced to 60 mph in work zone.

Nelson County

Route 29 South – Replacing box culvert at tributary to Muddy Creek. Speed reduced to 45 mph; traffic reduced to one lane in both directions sharing northbound lanes once crossovers are completed.

City of Newport News

Route 173 – Replacing bridge on Denbigh Boulevard (Route 173) over I-64. Bridge traffic reduced to one lane in each direction. Access to Denbigh Boulevard from Richneck Road closed.

City of Newport News/James City County/York County

I-64 Widening Project – Widening interstate. Speed limit reduced to 55 mph in work zone in both directions.

- **Segment II (exit 247 to exit 242)** – Single lane closures in place on I-64 in both directions, between east of Yorktown Road (exit 247) and west of Humelsine Parkway (exit 242). Two travel lanes will remain open in each direction.
- **Segment III (exit 242 to exit 234)** – Consecutive, long-term full ramp closure on Route 143 Merrimac Trail north to I-64 west will be in place. Follow detour signage to the Route 143 south on-ramp to I-64 west during the closure.

Northumberland County

Route 201 – Completing emergency repairs to damage from Tropical Storm Michael. Road closed to through traffic between Knights Run Road and Indian Valley Road. Detour in place.

Page County

Route 211 Business – Replacing bridge over Hawksbill Creek on West Main Street in Luray. Detour in place.

Pittsylvania County

Route 58 – Completing emergency repairs to westbound bridge over Sandy Creek. Eastbound bridge open to one lane of traffic in each direction.

Prince Edward County

Route 460 Business – Completing pedestrian trail project in Farmville. Intermittent lane closures possible.

Pulaski County

I-81 – Completing bridge work over I-81 at exit 92. Northbound right lane and shoulder closed for barrier wall installation.

Pulaski County/Montgomery County

I-81 – Replacing northbound bridge over the New River at the Pulaski/Montgomery County line. Shoulders closed between mile markers 103 and 105. Northbound on-ramp at exit 105 may be closed with detour in place. Speed limit reduced to 60 mph in work zone.

Rappahannock County

Route 211/522 – Replacing westbound bridge over the North Fork Thornton River. Traffic reduced to one lane in each direction, sharing eastbound bridge.

Richmond County

Route 360 West – Completing emergency pipe and slope repair. Right lane closed near the intersection of Route 697 (Indian Field Road).

Roanoke County

Route 220 – Replacing pipe on Route 220 north near the Clearbrook area by Back Creek. Right lane northbound closed.

Scott County

Route 23 – Replacing northbound bridge over North Fork Holston River in the Wadlow Gap area. Traffic reduced to one lane both directions, sharing the southbound bridge.

Spotsylvania County

I-95 – Improving the exit 118 (Thornburg) interchange and replacing the I-95 overpass. All travel lanes open; concrete barriers in place along the shoulder in both directions through work zone.

Stafford County

I-95 – Improving interchange at exit 140 (Courthouse Road). All travel lanes open; concrete barriers in place along the shoulder in both directions through work zone.

Stafford County, City of Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania County

I-95 – Building three additional general purpose lanes on I-95 south from north of exit 133 in Stafford County to just south of exit 130 in Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania County. All travel lanes remain open; concrete barriers installed along the left shoulder of I-95 in both directions.

Wythe County

I-77/I-81 Overlap – High traffic volumes could slow or stop vehicles through this eight-mile stretch. Be alert for delays on I-77 north at the I-81 merge due to work to add a merge lane.
