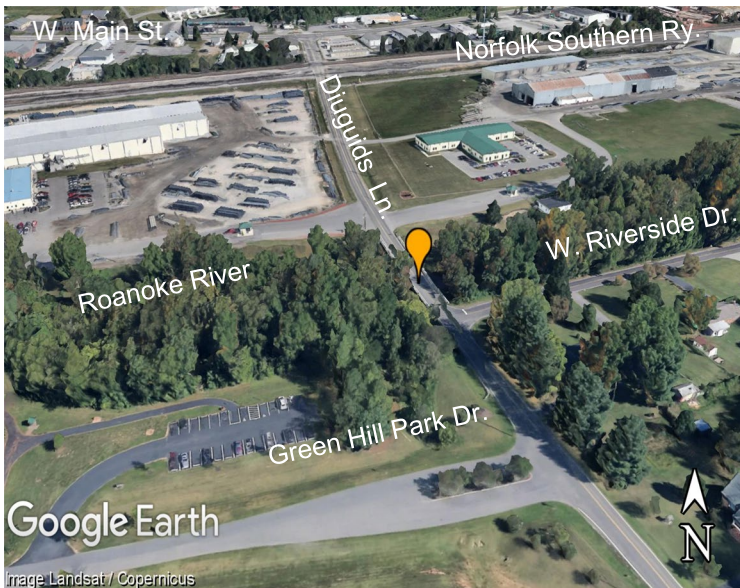
This public meeting is being held to provide an opportunity for people to ask questions and learn more about the project.

Project Overview



Cost – \$2.6 million

Purpose – Replace an aging bridge built in 1961

From – 0.027 mile south of the intersection of Route 639 (West Riverside Drive)

To – 0.068 mile north of the intersection with Route 639 (West Riverside Drive)

Schedule - Work to replace the bridge is expected to begin in fall 2021 and be completed in late spring 2022.

Detour - During construction, traffic will be detoured for 45 days starting in late January or early February 2022.

Improvements – The project will replace the bridge's riding surface, railing and concrete beams.

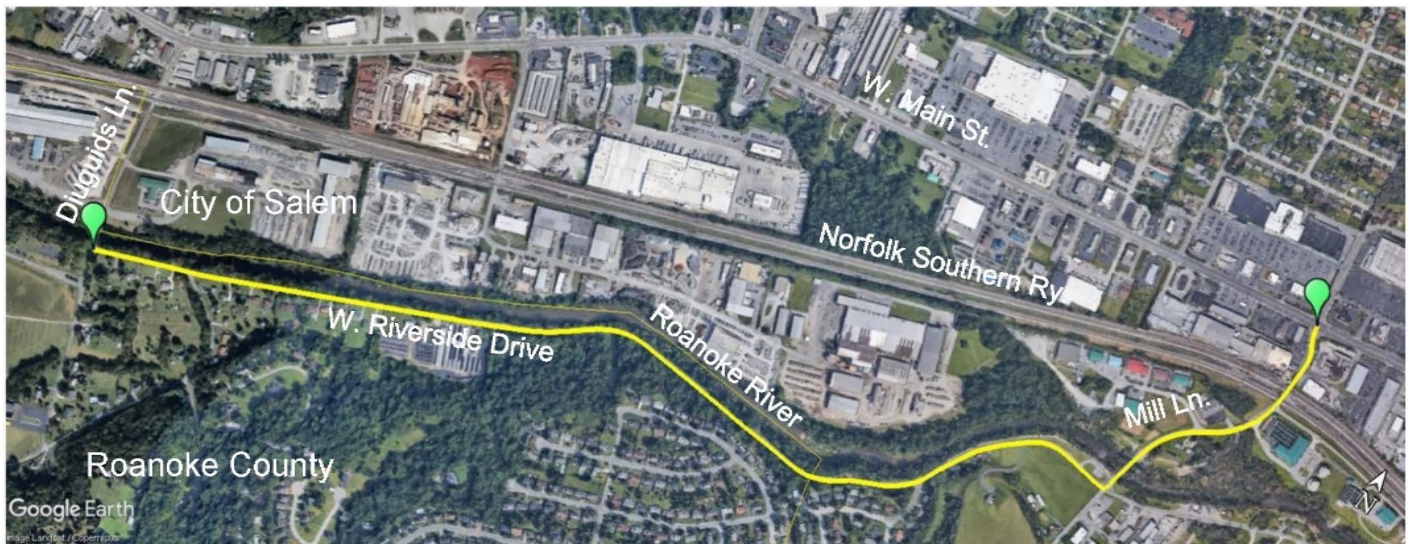
Typical Work Hours and Lane Closures

- Typical work hours are expected to be Monday through Saturday during daytime hours with occasional work on Sunday.
- Night work is possible at times.
- During construction, traffic will be detoured for 45 days starting in late January or early February 2022. Signs will be posted two weeks in advance of the road closure. The traffic detour will be removed by March 31, 2022.
- Local governments and emergency services will be coordinated prior to the bridge closure and detour being in place.



Detour Route

- Drivers will use Mill Lane or West Riverside Drive to detour and return to Diuguids Lane.
- The detour is 3.6 miles long and takes approximately nine minutes to drive.
- Drivers can expect short-term lane closures with flaggers controlling traffic on West Riverside Drive periodically throughout the project.
- Access to Green Hill Park, private entrances and businesses will be maintained at all times.
